Description: Provision of Supply and Delivery of Stationery for a Period Not Exceeding 36 Months at King Shaka International Airport.

Question

We refer to **RFQ 29807** (Provision of Supply and Delivery of Stationery for a Period Not Exceeding 36 Months at King Shaka International Airport).

We would like to request clarification on the following points ahead of the closing date:

1. Section 2 (Background, Purpose and Scope of Work) lists a single "Contract Quantity" for each of the 28-line items. Could you please confirm whether these figures represent the total requirement for the full 36-month contract term, or an annual requirement to be repeated each year?
2. If the quantities represent a total 36-month figure, should bidders assume an even split across the three contract years for the Section 5.2 Pricing Schedule (SBD 3.3), or does a different delivery schedule apply?

Answer

Thank you for your clarification request regarding RFQ 29807: Provision of Supply and Delivery of Stationery for a Period Not Exceeding 36 Months at King Shaka International Airport.

Please note that the Contract Quantity indicated in Section 2 represents the total estimated quantity required for the full 36-month contract period.

Bidders are required to provide pricing for the 36-month contract period, with the total contract quantities split equally across the three contract years in the Section 5.2 Pricing Schedule (SBD 3.3).

Accordingly, bidders should divide the stated Contract Quantity by three and reflect the resulting quantities under Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3, respectively.

For example, where the total Contract Quantity is 60 units, the bidder should price 20 units for Year 1, 20 units for Year 2 and 20 units for Year 3, resulting in a total of 60 units over the 36-month contract period.

Kindly ensure that your pricing submission is completed accordingly.
