## TENDER NOTICE

King Cetshwayo District Municipality (KCDM) invite service providers, already registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD), to tender for the King Cetshwayo Repairs and Refurbishment Emergency Intervention Programme.

Interested parties must pay a **compulsory** non-refundable tender deposit fee of **R901,00** payable for each of the three tenders (in line with approved tariffs of Council as per the tender value). Payments can be made at the **King Cetshwayo District Municipality Cashier Offices (Pay-Hall) in Richards Bay** OR via EFT to (First National Bank, King Cetshwayo District Municipality, Acc. 62943444125, Bank Code: 210554) **Ref. Tender documents will be issued **ON SITE**, before the commencement of the **compulsory** site briefing meetings, only to tenderers who can show proof confirming to have paid the tender deposit by **Wednesday, 20 May 2026 at 14h00**. Proof will be by receipt issued by the KCDM cashier offices or proof of payment (EFT) from a bank (**BRING PROOF TO COMPULSORY SITE BRIEFING**).

The King Cetshwayo District Municipality will strive to achieve targeted procurement in accordance with Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act Regulation 2022. The Tenderer, should have CIDB contractor grading as per the table below. The tender that fails to meet the stipulated criteria will be regarded as non-responsive.

Any tender submitted by a person(s) who is in the service of the state or if that person(s) is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state or who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the Municipality shall not be considered in terms of regulation 44 of the Municipal Supply Chain Regulations. Only service providers who are registered on Central Supplier Database (CSD), visit the website at [www.csd.gov.za](http://www.csd.gov.za) can submit a tender.

Prospective service providers are required to ensure full completion and correctness of information when responding to MBD 4 and all other required declarations in the document. The municipality reserves the right to validate the correctness of the declarations through various databases inclusive of the Central Supplier Database (CSD). Failure to fully complete and/or provide correct information in the declarations will be regarded by the employer as a non-responsive tender.

The following criteria in "Functionality Evaluation Criteria", will be applicable for the functionality and compliance and maximum weight of each criterion is indicated in brackets and any tenderer who scores less than 70 percent, in respect of "functionality" will be regarded as submitting a non-responsive tender and will be disqualified.

**TENDER BOX:** A completed tender in a sealed envelope **BEARING THE TENDER NUMBER** must be deposited in the **Municipality's tender box Unit at King Cetshwayo District Municipality Offices at Prince Mangosuthu Buthelezi House, Corner Kruger Rand and Barbados Bay Road, Richards Bay CBD on or before the closing date**. Tenders will be opened in public. Tenders received after the due date and time will not be opened nor considered further.

It will be the tenderer's responsibility to check the document on receipt for completeness and to notify the employer of any discrepancies or omissions. It is the tenderer's responsibility to provide all the data and information requested in the forms required and failure to do so may be regarded by the employer as a non-responsive tender. Submissions may only be done on documentation supplied by the Municipality.
