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## 1. Scope of Work

This specification outlines the minimum requirements for a 36-month pest control service contract across designated Transnet Engineering depots. The appointed Contractor shall be fully responsible for delivering all services described herein, ensuring compliance with all applicable South African standards (including SANS 10133: Pest Management and the Occupational Health and Safety Act, Act 85 of 1993).

The Contractor shall provide all labour, tools, equipment, materials, consumables, facilities, testing, and supervision necessary for the effective delivery of pest control services. Any omissions, ambiguities, or sub-standard provisions identified in this specification must be highlighted by the tenderer at the tender stage, with optional pricing provided for corrective measures.

This contract will be awarded per depot, with evaluation criteria including cost, BBBEE compliance, and adherence to the stated technical requirements. The depots requiring this service include:

- Kimberley
- Bloemfontein
- Postmasburg
- De Aar
- Upington
- Lime Acres

This specification requirement covers all the requirements that will be needed to inform the supplier to carry out what is expected from him/her: The contract will be awarded as a pest control project and the contractor will be responsible for all the work specified.

This specification states the minimum requirements relating to the work and in no way absolves the contractor from responsibility for cleaning services. Any omissions or sub-standard requirements of this specification must be brought to the attention of Transnet Engineering Depots at tender stage and optional prices for addressing such omissions must be provided.

The Supplier shall supply all the labour, tools, material, equipment, consumables, facilities, testing, and supervision required for the provision of Pest Control services for the duration of the 36 months contract. The depots requiring this service is as follows:

**This tender will be evaluated and awarded per depot based on the relevant SCM criteria (Cost, BBBEE , etc).**

## **2. Site Inspection**

Tenderers must visit the site to familiarize themselves with all the aspects involved relating to the project that must be done.

## **3. Information Required**

Tenderers shall confirm that the items that they are offering comply at a standard not less than the minimum required requirement asked for in the specifications. Tenderers must comply to these specifications, but alternative offers may, in addition, also be submitted. Such alternative offers must be fully motivated and substantiated separately.

#### 4. Regulations and Standards

**The Contractor must comply with all relevant South African legislation and standards, including:**

- Occupational Health and Safety Act, 85 of 1993 (OHS Act) – Ensuring safe application of chemicals and equipment handling within workplace environments.
- Hazardous Substances Act, 15 of 1973 – Regulation of restricted pesticides and chemicals.
- Fertilizers, Farm Feeds, Agricultural Remedies and Stock Remedies Act, 36 of 1947 – Registration and control of pest control chemicals.
- SANS 10133: Health and Safety in Pest Control Operations – Requirements for safe handling, storage, application, and disposal of pesticides.
- SANS 10206: The Handling, Storage and Disposal of Pesticides – Specific safety requirements for operational activities.
- SANS 10043: Code of Practice for The Application of Rodenticides – Compliance for rodent management.
- SANS 10407: Fumigation of Buildings – Technical requirements for safe and effective fumigation practices.
- National Environmental Management Act (NEMA), 107 of 1998 – Ensuring environmental responsibility during pest control operations.
- Basic Conditions of Employment Act (BCEA), 75 of 1997 – Contractor compliance with employee working conditions.

<b>5.1</b>	<b>The service performed must be according to set requirements. All designated areas to be monitored and checked as per agreement. An integrated pest programme must be based on:</b>	<b>Comply Yes/No</b>

<b>6.1</b>	<b>Treatment Methods</b>	<b>Comply Yes/No</b>
<b>6.1.1</b>	Spraying, rodent bait, chemicals and fogging.	
<b>6.2</b>	<b>Areas of Treatment</b>	<b>Comply Yes/No</b>
<b>6.2.1</b>	Offices, archives, stores, kitchens and change rooms.	
<b>6.3</b>	<b>Pest Coverage</b>	<b>Comply Yes/No</b>
<b>6.3.1</b>	Mice, rats, cockroaches, normal black ants, snakes catchers, Bees, Wasps etc.

<b>6.4.1</b>	At completion of each visit, the pest control officer will present to Transnet Representative, a written report and invoice.	
<b>6.5</b>	<b>Reporting</b>	<b>Comply Yes/No</b>
<b>6.5.1</b>	Completed at the time of service by the pest control officer and reviewed with the Transnet Representative following each visit.	
<b>6.6</b>	<b>Emergency Service</b>	<b>Comply Yes/No</b>
<b>6.6.1</b>	Response within 8 hours and service performed Monday to Friday 07:30 to 16:00.	
<b>7.</b>	<b>Service Frequency</b>	
<b>7.1</b>	<b>Rodent control</b>	<b>Comply Yes/No</b>
<b>7.1.1</b>	Tamper proof bait stations should permanently be installed in admin buildings e.g. Main Admin building, Cafeteria, Engineering (PCO), Locomotives, RFR, Training, Wheels, cafeteria, Wagon Build and all mess facilities in the plant. Bait stations should be monitored and serviced every 4 weeks. Dead rodents must be removed on request.	

<b>7.2</b>	<b>Crawling Insects</b>	<b>Comply Yes/No</b>
<b>7.2.1</b>	Kitchens of Main Admin building, Locomotives, RFR, Cafeteria, Training, Wheels and Engineering (PCO) must be treated every 36 weeks with gel or surface spray for crawling insects. This is all depot dependant.	
<b>7.2.2</b>	Offices, archives, stores and change rooms every 36 weeks or as per request for insect control (e.g. ants, silverfish moths, paper lice, etc.)	
<b>7.2.3</b>	Shorter periods for cockroaches may be necessary and must be specified in tender.	
<b>8.</b>	<b>HEALTH AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS</b>	<b>Comply Yes/No</b>
<b>8.1</b>	See the attach Contractor SHE File Index Pest Control	
<b>9.</b>	<b>General Information</b>	<b>Comply Yes/No</b>
<b>9.1</b>	The Contractor shall be registered as a Pest Control Officer with the Department of Agriculture.	
<b>9.2</b>	Transnet Engineering will not be responsible for any loss of or damage to any vehicles and equipment belonging to the Contractor, excepting loss or damage the proximate cause of which is the negligence of Transnet Engineering or its servants acting in the scope of their employment.	
<b>9.3</b>	The Contractor shall not interfere in any manner whatsoever with production nor shall he carry out any work or perform any act which affect production, security or Transnet Engineering's property except with the designated authorization of a Transnet Engineering representative	
<b>9.4</b>	<b>Snake Catching Call Out</b> – In the event that a snake or snakes has been seen on the depot that cannot be contained by the onsite staff, the supplier might be called out to the respective depots to catch and remove the identified snake.

- Bait stations should be serviced / topped up once a month.
- Fumigation packs should be serviced once a month.
- Snake catcher should be serviced as required.
