Both water use License application AND track record relating to Water Use License Application are required. Please confirm if client reference letters and a table of previous experience will suffice? Or do you require copies of the licences, to be considered as the "completion certificate" (track record)?

Reference letter/and or completion certificate must be submitted as proof for each project. The letter must include a brief description of completed services. Note: Both water use License application AND track record relating to Water Use License Application are required. Failure to submit experience in both requirements will result in a negative score.

Only table of experience and/or license only will not suffice. Reference letter/and or completion certificate must be submitted as per above requirement.

3. Annexure A Technical Submission (Page 32): Program/schedule must outline the timelines of this project. The work should be finalized within the gazetted timeframe (90 days). Can you confirm if this expected timeframe is accurate? Note that a full WULA is a lengthy process which includes administrative requirements, carrying out the specialist studies, a legislated 60-day comment period for public participation process, and the Department of Water and Sanitation have a gazetted timeframe of 90 days to assess the application and make a decision. This will exceed the anticipated timeframe specified.

The two activities mentioned are not depended upon each other. These activities can be done concurrently. According to the information provided by DWS during the preapplication process, public participation takes only 30 days.

Only Wetland and Geohydrological, or the supplementary geotechnical and a stormwater management included reports as well? We would like to ensure that all tenderers are quoting for the same scope in terms of the specialist assessment/refinement requirements.

All the studies conducted were requested by DWS during the pre-application process, the outcome was that Transnet must apply for WULA in terms of section 21C and I for the infrastructure including the outlet (Bioswale) as well as section 21J for de-watering activities. They further requested for rehabilitation plan to form part of the technical report. Should there be any additional technical report required by DWS apart from the one that had been compiled, the service provider will have to include it.
