3 PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

4 RFP INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Please sign documents [sign, stamp and date the bottom of each page] before uploading them on the system. The person or persons signing the submission must be legally authorised by the respondent to do so.

4.2 All returnable documents tabled in the Proposal Form [Section 5] must be returned with proposals.

- 4.3 Unless otherwise expressly stated, all Proposals furnished pursuant to this RFP shall be deemed to be offers. Any exceptions to this statement must be clearly and specifically indicated.
- 4.4 Any additional conditions must be embodied in an accompanying letter. Subject only to clause 15 [Alterations made by the Respondent to Bid Prices] of the General Bid Conditions, paragraph 12 below (Legal Review) and Section 6 of the RFP, alterations, additions or deletions must not be made by the Respondent to the actual RFP documents.

5 JOINT VENTURES OR CONSORTIUMS

Respondents who would wish to respond to this RFP as a Joint Venture [JV] or consortium with B-BBEE entities, must state their intention to do so in their RFP submission. Such Respondents must also submit a signed JV or consortium agreement between the parties clearly stating the percentage [%] split of business and the associated responsibilities of each party. If at the time of the bid submission such a JV or consortium agreement has not been concluded, the partners must submit confirmation in writing of their intention to enter into a JV or consortium agreement should they be awarded business by Transnet through this RFP process. This written confirmation must clearly indicate the percentage [%] split of business and the responsibilities of each party. In such cases, award of business will only take place once a signed copy of a JV or consortium agreement is submitted to Transnet.

Respondents are to note that for the purpose of Evaluation, a JV will be evaluated based on one consolidated B-BBEE score card (a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level verification certificate) as per the B-BBEE Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 preference point scoring.

6 PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT PREQUALIFICATION CRITERIA

6.1. Minimum B-BBEE level

Transnet has decided to set a minimum B-BBEE threshold for participation in this RFP process. The minimum B-BBEE threshold in this instance is a B-BBEE Status of Level 1 of 2 or better (1 being highest), and Respondents who do not have at least this B-BBEE status or higher will be disqualified.

7 COMMUNICATION

- 7.1 For specific queries relating to this RFP, an RFP Clarification Request Form should be submitted onto the system and to [Langanani Mphelo] email Langanani.mphelo@transnet.net before 12:00 pm on 14 November 2022 substantially in the form set out in Section 8 hereto. In the interest of fairness and transparency, Transnet's response to such a query will be published on the e-tender portal and Transnet website.

- 7.3 Respondents are to note that changes to its submission will not be considered after the closing date.
- 7.4 It is prohibited for Respondents to attempt, either directly or indirectly, to canvass any officer or employee of Transnet in respect of this RFP between the closing date and the date of the award of the business.
- 7.5 Respondents found to be in collusion with one another will be automatically disqualified and restricted from doing business with organs of state for a specified period.

8 CONFIDENTIALITY

All information related to this RFP is to be treated with strict confidence. In this regard Respondents are required to certify that they have acquainted themselves with the Non-Disclosure Agreement. All information related to a subsequent contract, both during and after completion thereof, will be treated with strict confidence. Should the need however arise to divulge any information related to this RFP or the subsequent contract, written approval must be obtained from Transnet.

9 COMPLIANCE

The successful Respondent [hereinafter referred to as the **Service provider(s)**] shall be in full and complete compliance with any and all applicable laws and regulations.

10 EMPLOYMENT EQUITY ACT

Respondents must comply with the requirements of the Employment Equity Act 55 of 1998 applicable to it including (but not limited to) Section 53 of the Employment Equity Act.

11 DISCLAIMERS

Respondents are hereby advised that Transnet is not committed to any course of action as a result of its issuance of this RFP and/or its receipt of Proposals. In particular, please note that Transnet reserves the right to:

- 11.1 modify the RFP's Goods/Services and request Respondents to re-bid on any such changes;
- 11.2 reject any Proposal which does not conform to instructions and specifications which are detailed herein;

- 11.3 disqualify Proposals submitted after the stated submission deadline [closing date];
- 11.4 award a contract in connection with this Proposal at any time after the RFP's closing date;
- 11.5 award a contract for only a portion of the proposed Goods/Services which are reflected in the scope of this RFP;
- 11.6 split the award of the contract between more than one Supplier/Service provider, should it at Transnet's discretion be more advantageous in terms of, amongst others, cost or developmental considerations;
- 11.7 cancel the bid process;
- validate any information submitted by Respondents in response to this bid. This would include, but is not limited to, requesting the Respondents to provide supporting evidence. By submitting a bid, Respondents hereby irrevocably grant the necessary consent to Transnet to do so;

12 LEGAL REVIEW

A Proposal submitted by a Respondent will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection of its proposed contractual terms and conditions by Transnet's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business. A material deviation from the Standard terms or conditions could result in disqualification.

13 SECURITY CLEARANCE

Acceptance of this bid could be subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent, its personnel providing the Goods/Services and its subcontractor(s) must obtain security clearance from the appropriate authorities to the level of **CONFIDENTIAL/ SECRET/TOP SECRET**. 14 NATIONAL TREASURY'S CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE

Respondents are required to self-register on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD) which has been established to centrally administer supplier information for all organs of state and facilitate the verification of certain key supplier information. Respondents must register on the CSD prior to submitting their bids. Business may not be awarded to a Respondent who has failed to register on the CSD. Only foreign suppliers with no local registered entity need not register on the CSD.

For this purpose, the attached SBD 1 form must be completed and submitted as a mandatory returnable document by the closing date and time of the bid.

15 TAX COMPLIANCE

Respondents must be compliant when submitting a proposal to Transnet and remain compliant for the entire contract term with all applicable tax legislation, including but not limited to the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962) and Value Added Tax Act, 1991 (Act No. 89 of 1991).

It is a condition of this bid that the tax matters of the successful Respondents be in order, or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Service (SARS) to meet the Respondents tax obligations.

SECTION 3: BACKGROUND, OVERVIEW AND SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

1 BACKGROUND

Fire extinguishers is and active fire protection device used to extinguish small fires often in emergency situations. It is therefore imperative that this product is always readily available, usable and in sound operating condition thus to ensure in any unforeseen event of a fire lives, equipment and documentation can be secured using available, operational, and serviced firefighting protection equipment.

The health and safety of workers are of top priority, the advent of SCBA revolutionized the fire service whereas firefighters regularly facing devastating exposure to smoke and harmful toxins, SCBA offer protection and supply firefighters the air to breathe while operating inside immediately dangerous to life or health (IDLH) environments. SCBA essentially serve as the firefighters' lungs in an otherwise airless atmosphere.

2 EXECUTIVE OVERVIEW

Whereas Transnet is seeking a partner(s) to provide solutions for its **reconditioning**, **high pressure testing**, **refurbishment**, **calibration of fire appliances**, **calibration of scales**, **gauges and the supply of miscellaneous goods/consumables** nationally, it also seeks to improve its current processes for providing these Goods/Services to its end user community throughout its locations.

The selected Supplier/Service provider(s) must share in the mission and business objectives of Transnet. These mutual goals will be met by meeting contractual requirements and new challenges in an environment of teamwork, joint participation, flexibility, innovation and open communications. In this spirit of partnership, Transnet and its Supplier/Service provider(s) will study the current ways they do business to enhance current practices and support processes and systems. Such a partnership will allow Transnet to reach higher levels of quality, service and profitability.

Specifically, Transnet seeks to benefit from this partnership in the following ways:

- 2.1 Transnet must receive reduced cost of acquisition and improved service benefits resulting from the Supplier/Service provider's economies of scale and streamlined service processes.
- 2.2 Transnet must achieve appropriate availability that meets user needs while reducing costs for both Transnet and the chosen Supplier/Service provider(s).
- 2.3 Transnet must receive proactive improvements from the Supplier/Service provider with respect to supply/provision of Goods/Services and related processes.
- 2.4 Transnet's overall competitive advantage must be strengthened by the chosen Supplier/Service provider's leading edge technology and service delivery systems.
- 2.5 Transnet end users must be able to rely on the chosen Supplier/Service provider's personnel for service enquiries, recommendations and substitutions.

2.6 Transnet must reduce costs by streamlining its acquisition of Goods/Services, including managed service processes on a Group basis.

3 SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

3.1 The work entails reconditioning, high pressure testing, hydro testing, refurbishment, calibration of fire appliances, calibration of scales, gauges and the supply of consumables and accessories for a period of three years (36 months) on an as and when required basis. NB! All services provided shall be inclusive of supply, collection, delivery and in accordance all relevant and applicable standards and requirements.

3.1.1. Reconditioning and refurbishment of fire appliances shall include but not limited to:

- 3.1.1.1. The collection and delivery of various types and sizes of Transnet owned portable fire appliances. (Service provider to provide own transport and manpower for the collection and delivery and collect at no cost should need arise to be returned for whatsoever reason).
- 3.1.1.2. Reconditioning and refurbishment of fire appliances (shall include refilling and recharging)
- 3.1.1.3. Hydrostatic pressure test of Transnet owned portable fire appliances of various sizes.
- 3.1.1.4. Hydro Testing of Transnet owned Self Containing Breathing Apparatus (SCBA).

The above-mentioned work shall be carried out and maintained in accordance with all relevant and applicable standards as follows but not limited to:

- SANS 1475, SANS 10105-1, NFPA 10, SANAS Servicing, HPT, and refurbishment of fire appliances
- NFPA 1981, SANAS/NFPA 1852 Standard on Open-Circuit Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) for Emergency Services

3.1.2. Supply and deliver shall include but not limited to:

- 3.1.2.1. New Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) on request. (Service provider shall provide own transport for the delivery and collect at no cost should need arise to be returned for whatsoever reason)
- 3.1.2.2. New portable fire appliances on request. (Service provider shall provide own transport for the delivery and collect at no cost should need arise to be returned for whatsoever reason)
- 3.1.2.3. Miscellaneous goods/Consumables on request. (Service provider shall provide own transport for the delivery and collect at no cost should need arise to be returned for whatsoever reason)

- 3.1.2.4. Various spares parts on request (Service provider shall provide own transport for the delivery and collect at no cost should need arise to be returned for whatsoever reason)
- 3.1.2.5. Various foam inclusive of annual testing thereof and issue test certificates to Transnet Hazmat Fire & Emergency Services upon delivery. (Service provider shall provide own transport for the delivery and collect at no cost should need arise to be returned for whatsoever reason)
- 3.1.2.6. Various foam inclusive of annual testing thereof and issue test certificates to Transnet Hazmat Fire & Emergency Services upon delivery. (Service provider shall provide own transport for the delivery and collect at no cost should need arise to be returned for whatsoever reason).
- 3.1.2.7. Scales and pressure gauges on request. (Service provider shall provide own transport for the delivery and collect at no cost should need arise to be returned for whatsoever reason)

3.2 **Performance Requirements**

- 3.2.1. A Transnet HFES Representative will together with the service provider sign a separate register recording all firefighting equipment leaving the premises.
- 3.2.2. Provide and submit valid certified copies (not older than 3mnts) of SAQCC 1475 registered Service Technicians Certificate (min of 6 technicians).
- 3.2.3. All portable extinguishers servicing, maintenance or refurbishment shall be performed at the supplier's SANS 1475 accredited premises.
- 3.2.4. The successful contractor/bidder to produce to Transnet Hazmat Fire & Emergency Services department officials their compliances certifications upon date of the premises inspection.
- 3.2.5. The supplier to provide HPT certificates for all CO2 extinguishers an SCBA cylinders due for HPT as per manufacturers specification and requirements upon delivery of equipment.
- 3.2.6. If, during servicing, powder is removed for the effective inspection and control of a cylinder, the powder may be re-used, subject to:
 - 3.2.6.1. The powder shall be sieved and if it is determined, during sieving, that the powder is free from lumps, the powder may be re-used; if not, it shall be discarded.
 - 3.2.6.2. C02 extinguishers shall be charged with C02 that complies with the requirements of SABS 1567.
 - 3.2.6.3. CO2 extinguishers shall not be topped up but shall be emptied and fully recharged.
 - 3.2.6.4. Re-coating of aluminium/alloy steel cylinders shall only be carried out in terms of the manufacturer's specification.
- 3.2.7. If any damage/rust/dents to the seams or joints of the cylinder is observed, remove the extinguisher from service and must be condemned free of charge (pricing).

- 3.2.8. If the registered person does not consider the severity and extent of corrosion to be serious; clean, repaint, service/refurbish and re-label the cylinder in a way that ensures compliance with the requirements of the original manufacturer.
- 3.2.9. Check all components for corrosion and physical damage (i.e., breakage, deformation, cracks, discolouration of plastic parts, etc.). If necessary, replace parts with the correct components recommended and supplied by the fire extinguisher manufacturer. If such components are not available, use parts that comply with the requirements of the original manufacturer. If this is not possible, the extinguisher shall be condemned and replaced with a new one.
- 3.2.10. Determine the full mass of the extinguisher and, if it is found to vary by more than 5% from the marked full mass, present the extinguisher for a major service.
- 3.2.11. If no mass is marked on the extinguisher, determine the actual mass, and record it on the new service label attached to the extinguisher.



2. **DEFINITIONS**

- (a) "all applicable taxes" includes value-added tax, pay as you earn, income tax, unemployment insurance fund contributions and skills development levies;
- (b) **"B-BBEE"** means broad-based black economic empowerment as defined in section 1 of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (c) "B-BBEE status level of contributor" means the B-BBEE status received by a measured entity based on its overall performance using the relevant scorecard contained in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (d) "bid" means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the supply/provision of services, works or goods, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;
- (e) **"Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act"** means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (f) **"EME"** means an Exempted Micro Enterprise as defines by Codes of Good Practice under section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);

- (k) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties.

unless the intended sub-contractor is an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the sub-contract.

THE NATIONAL INDUSTRIAL PARTICIPATION PROGRAMME

INTRODUCTION

The National Industrial Participation Programme (NIPP), which is applicable to all government procurement contracts that have an imported content, became effective on the 1 September 1996. The NIP policy and guidelines were fully endorsed by Cabinet on 30 April 1997. In terms of the Cabinet decision, all state and parastatal purchases / lease contracts (for goods, works and services) entered into after this date, are subject to the NIPP requirements. NIPP is obligatory and therefore must be complied with. The Industrial Participation Secretariat (IPS) of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) is charged with the responsibility of administering the programme.

1. PILLARS OF THE PROGRAMME

- 1.1 The NIPP obligation is benchmarked on the imported content of the contract. Any contract having an imported content equal to or exceeding US\$5 million or other currency equivalent to US\$5 million will have a NIP obligation. This threshold of US\$5 million can be reached as follows:
 - (a) Any single contract with imported content exceeding US\$5 million.

or

(b) Multiple contracts for the same goods, works or services each with imported content exceeding US\$3 million awarded to one seller over a 2 year period which in total exceeds US\$5 million.

or

(c) A contract with a renewable option clause, where should the option be exercised the total value of the imported content will exceed US\$5 million.

or

- (d) Multiple suppliers of the same goods, works or services under the same contract, where the value of the imported content of each allocation is equal to or exceeds US\$ 3 million worth of goods, works or services to the same government institution, which in total over a two (2) year period exceeds US\$5 million.
- 1.2 The NIP obligation applicable to suppliers in respect of sub-paragraphs 1.1 (a) to 1.1 (c) above will amount to 30% of the imported content whilst suppliers in respect of paragraph 1.1 (d) shall incur 30% of the total NIPP obligation on a *pro-rata* basis.
- 1.3 To satisfy the NIPP obligation, the DTI would negotiate and conclude agreements such as investments, joint ventures, sub-contracting, licensee production, export promotion, sourcing arrangements and research and development (R&D) with partners or suppliers.
- 1.4 A period of seven years has been identified as the time frame within which to discharge the obligation.

2. REQUIREMENTS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY

- 2.1 In order to ensure effective implementation of the programme, successful bidders (contractors) are required to, immediately after the award of a contract that is in excess of **R10 million** (ten million Rands), submit details of such a contract to the DTI for reporting purposes.
- 2.2 The purpose for reporting details of contracts in excess of the amount of R10 million (ten million Rands) is to cater for multiple contracts for the same goods, works or services; renewable contracts and multiple suppliers for the same goods, works or services under the same contract as provided for in paragraphs 1.1.(b) to 1.1. (d) above.

3. BID SUBMISSION AND CONTRACT REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF BIDDERS AND SUCCESSFUL BIDDERS (CONTRACTORS)

- 3.1 Bidders are required to sign and submit this Standard Bidding Document (SBD 5) together with their bid documentation at the closing date and time of the bid.
- 3.2 In order to accommodate multiple contracts for the same goods, works or services; renewable contracts and multiple suppliers for the same goods, works or services under the same contract as indicated in sub-paragraphs 1.1 (b) to 1.1 (d) above and to enable the DTI in determining the NIPP obligation, successful bidders (contractors) are required, immediately after being officially notified about any successful bid with a value in excess of R10 million (ten million Rands), to contact and furnish the DTI with the following information:
 - Bid number;
 - · Description of the goods or services;
 - Date on which the contract was awarded;
 - Name, address and contact details of the contractor;
 - Value of the contract; and
 - Imported content of the contract, if possible.

 - a. the contractor and the DTIC will determine the NIPP obligation;
 - b. the contractor and the DTI will sign the NIPP obligation agreement;
 - c. the contractor will submit a performance guarantee to the DTI;
 - d. the contractor will submit a business concept for consideration and approval by the DTI;
 - e. upon approval of the business concept by the DTI, the contractor will submit detailed business plans outlining the business concepts;
 - f. the contractor will implement the business plans; and
 - g. the contractor will submit bi-annual progress reports on approved plans to the DTI.
- 4.2 The NIPP obligation agreement is between the DTI and the successful bidder (contractor) and, therefore, does not involve the purchasing institution.
