#### 1. PURPOSE

The Kwazulu-Natal Growth Fund Trust (KGFT) invites quotations from suitably qualifies service providers to provide KGFT with a Key Individual for KGFT Capital.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

KZN Growth Fund Trust (KGFT) is a Trust, established and capitalised by the Provincial Government to provide debt and equity. The main objective of the KGFT is to provide support for creating and enabling environment for activities that create jobs and accelerate the economic development of KZN whilst promoting Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE).

## 2.1 Procurement Philosophy

It is the policy of KGFT, when purchasing goods and obtaining services to follow a course of optimum value and efficiency by adopting best purchasing practices in supply chain management, ensuring that open and fair competition has prevailed, with due regard being given to the importance of:

- a) The promotion, development and support of businesses from disadvantaged communities (small, medium, micro enterprises, as well as established businesses within those communities) in terms of its BEE Policy;
- b) The promotion of national and regional local service providers and agents before considering overseas service providers and;
- c) The development, promotion and support for the moral values that underpin the above, in terms of KGFT Business Ethics and Guidelines which requires that all commercial conduct be based on ethical and moral values and sound business practice. This value system governs all commercial behaviour within KGFT.

The KGFT wishes to engage with service providers who are equally committed to maintain high quality services and better pricing

#### 3. SCOPE OF SERVICES REQUIRED

KGF Capital (Pty) Ltd is a registered FSP with a Category II license. KGF Capital is fully controlled by the KZN Growth Fund Trust which is a provincial DFI under the KZN Department of Economic Development, Tourism, and Environmental Affairs. The company is based in the KZN Province and is looking to appoint an FSCA approved Key Individual with experience in Private Equity. The Key Individual will be appointed on a 12-month fixed term contract with an option to extend. The role does not require full-time presence in the office, however there will be times when you will be expected to be physically at the office.

- 3.1 The Key individual will be responsible for the management or oversight of the rendering of a financial service by the representatives of KGF Capital.
  - Appointment and debarment of representatives.
  - Drafting of development plans and supervision reports for representatives.
  - Monitoring of financial services rendered by representatives.
  - Maintaining the register of representatives.
  - Liaising with representatives, service providers, the FSCA, and other FSPs.
- 3.2 The Key Individual must establish and maintain the compliance function this includes ensuring compliance and adherence to the Financial Advisory and Intermediary Services (FAIS) Act and subordinate legislation.
  - Ensuring that KGF Capital maintains operational ability.
  - Ensuring that KGF Capital remains financially sound.
  - Ensuring the internal control structures and procedures are in place to enable adherence to the FAIS Act and relevant subordinate legislation.
  - Ensuring the appropriate risk control measures are in place and that the risks of the KGF Capital are effectively monitored.
  - Ensuring that complaints are handled in an effective and procedurally fair manner.

#### 4. CONTRACT DURATION

The Services will be provided over a 12 (twelve) month period.

#### 5. AWARD OF THE RFP

KGFT is not obliged to accept and award this tender to the lowest bidder or any other bidder.

#### **6.2 FUNCTIONALITY EVALUATION**

Scores will be tabulated to 100 points. Respondents must score 70 points and over to be assessed on their financial offer and preference score.

 or  $Ps = 90\left(1 + \frac{Pt - Pmax}{Pmax}\right)$ 

Where

Ps = Points scored for price of tender under consideration

Pt = Price of tender under consideration

Pmax = Price of highest acceptable tender

#### 4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

- 4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
  - (a) an invitation for tender for income-generating contracts, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the highest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system; or
  - (b) any other invitation for tender, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the lowest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system,

then the organ of state must indicate the points allocated for specific goals for both the 90/10 and 80/20 preference point system.
