

**SPECIFICATION FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A CONSULTING ENGINEERING COMPANY FOR THE PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE CONDITION ASSESSMENT OF THE TRAINING CENTRE AT VIMP, FORMERLY KNOWN AS VOPI, CAMPUS OF THE ARC**

**Compulsory Technical Requirements:**

**1. Provision of the following professional engineering services:**

- i) Mechanical Engineering.
- ii) Electrical Engineering.
- iii) Civil Engineering and Structural Engineering.
- iv) Quantity Surveying.
- v) Fire Safety and Protection.

**NB: All professionals should be registered with their respective professional bodies**

**Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA);**

**South African Institution of Civil Engineering (SAICE);**

**and any other relevant professional body).**

- 2. Conduct a detailed assessment of the building and produce a report.
- 3. Compile a detailed specification of the works and the bill of quantities of remedial works to be done.
- 4. Cost estimate and project duration for remedial works.

**Compulsory Evaluation Requirements**

- 1. Three contactable reference letters of projects completed of more than R3 million each (**completion letters should be on the letterhead of company**).
- 2. Professional Indemnity insurance of at least R5 million per claim.
- 3. Public liability insurance of at least R5 million.
