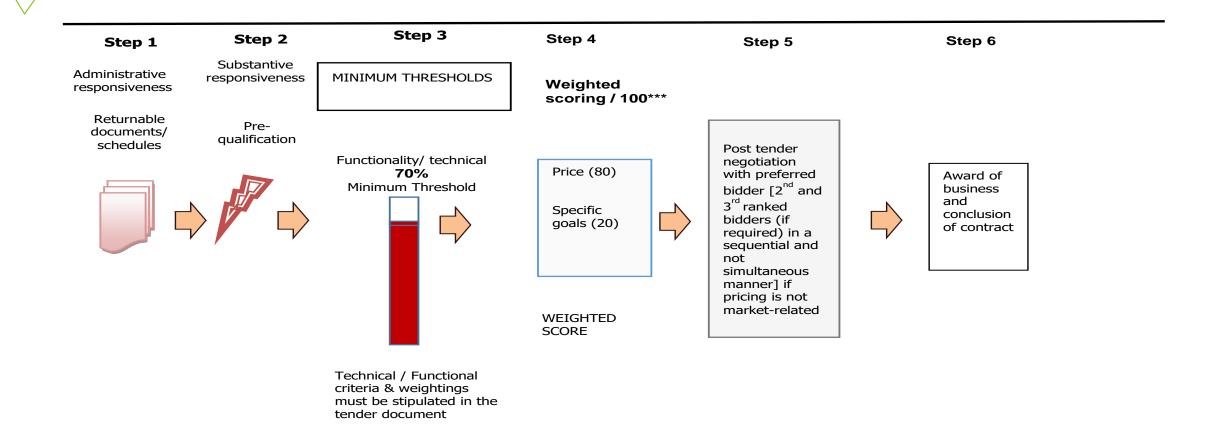

 Claim Form.



STEP FIVE: Post Tender Negotiations (if applicable)

- The respondent is to note that Transnet may not award a contract if the price offered is not market related. In this regard, Transnet reserves the right to engage in PTN with the view to achieving a market-related price or to cancel the tender.
- Should Transnet conduct post tender negotiations, the respondent will be requested to provide their best and final offers to Transnet based on such negotiations. Where a market related price has been achieved through negotiation, the contract will be awarded to the Respondent.

STEP SIX: Award of business and conclusion of contract

- Immediately after approval to award the contract has been received, the bidder will be informed of the acceptance of his/their Bid by
 way of a Letter of Award. Thereafter the final contract will be concluded with the Respondent.
- A final contract will be concluded and entered into with the successful Bidder at the acceptance of a letter of award by the Respondent.

- Respondents must submit valid proof of their B-BBEE status in accordance with the B-BBEE Preference points claim form
- A trust, consortium or joint venture (including unincorporated consortia and joint ventures) <u>must</u> submit a <u>consolidated B-BBEE Status Level verification certificate for every separate bid.</u>
- ➤ Bidder are to ensure that they approach a SANAS accredited verification agency to issue them with a consolidated B-BBEE Certificate should they wish to bid as a trust, consortium or joint venture.
- > Bidder MAY NOT SUBMIT a Sworn Affidavit if they are bidding as a trust, consortium or joint venture.
