Tenders must be placed in the Municipal Tender Box before 12h00 on **Friday**, <u>18</u> <u>March 2022</u> situated at the Supply Chain Management Offices, 11 Lind Street, Swellendam after which tenders will be opened in public. Tenders may only be submitted on the prescribed tender documents and must include the Tax Compliance Status <u>PIN</u> as issued by <u>SARS</u>.

Late bids and bids received by E-Mail or Facsimile will not be considered. Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated in accordance with the Swellendam Municipality's preferential procurement policy and its Supply Chain Management Policy. The <u>80/20</u>-point system will be applicable.

Functionality criteria will be assessed and scored as prescribed by PPPFA Regulation 5 and a minimum threshold of 70 points out of 100 points applies. A tender that fails to meet the minimum functionality threshold will be regarded as an unacceptable tender.

Additional objective criteria as per section 2(1)(f) of the PPPFA, will apply, as indicated in the tender document.

The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or award a contract to the service provider scoring the highest number of points.
