Question and Answers for the enquiry:

1	Please confirm your exact requirement under no. 2 of the Mandatory requirements as we are not sure what is meant by "...and the approved security strategy". Do you simply require the PSIRA Certificates of the Directors and Operational Managers, or is there other documentation also required?
Answer	We require the valid PSIRA Certificates of the Directors and Operational Managers
2	With regards to no. 3 of the Mandatory Criteria "Certified copies of verifiable proof of valid PSIRA registration for proposed CPO's and static guards. Please can you confirm how many the "proposed" number is as this cannot be located anywhere. How many PSIRA Certificates for CPO's and Static Guards?
Answer	At least 20 CPO and 10 static guards
	With regards to no. 5 of the Mandatory Criteria "lawful availability of firearms intended for deployment". Please can you confirm how many "firearms" as this cannot be located anywhere. How many firearms will suffice?
Answer	50 or more handguns and 10 Self-loading rifles
3	With regards to no. 8 of the Mandatory Criteria "12-months valid Security Clearance with no convictions at tender closing". Please note that the SAPS Criminal Clearance certificates are only valid for 6 months. Will this suffice?
Answer	Yes it will suffice
4	Close Protection Officers (Grade B): Is it mandatory for the proposed Close Protection Officers (Grade B) to possess a formal Close Protection Officer (CPO) qualification, or will candidates with extensive close protection experience and a proven operational background be considered acceptable?
Answer	It is mandatory that all CPO candidates possess a formal CPO certificate
	Curriculum Vitae (CVs): How many personnel CVs are required to be submitted as part of the tender response? And should the CVs contain ALL the desired Qualifications, IDs and competency certificates and Training records.

Answer	At least 20 CPO CV;s and 10 static guards
5	Firearm Licences and Competencies: What is the minimum number of firearm licences and firearm competency certificates that must be provided with the tender submission?
Answer	50 or more handguns and 10 Self-loading rifles
6	Vehicle Documentation: Are bidders required to submit NATIS registration documents for the proposed vehicles, or will a fleet register/asset list indicating company-owned vehicles be sufficient for evaluation purposes?
Answer	The vehicle documentation must be submitted for the specific vehicles that the supplier intends to utilise for the contract or a letter of agreement/lease with a reputable hiring company that will be able to supply the appropriate vehicles for close protection as was specified in the clarification meeting
7	Bill of Quantities (BOQ): Is there a detailed BOQ available indicating the estimated quantities required for each security resource, vehicle type, or item specified in the tender documentation?
Answer	This is an as and when required contract the specific number of resources required is difficult to estimate as it can change on a weekly/monthly basis
8	Will the minutes of the briefing session be made available and uploaded to the tender platform?
Answer	The Presentation is loaded in the space of minutes
9	With regard to pricing, could you please advise whether there is an estimated number of kilometres to be travelled under the contract? This information will assist us in accurately determining and pricing the rate per kilometre (R/km).
Answer	There is no estimated number of KM to be travelled it this can differ drastically depending on the principal location and destination that they travel to.
10	Total number of personnel registration and grading required for evaluation purposes Total number of VIP vehicles required for evaluation purposes Total number of CPO personnel capability and readiness
Answer	Vehicles is 15 or more unmarked SUV;s for Close Protection CPO's are at least 20 trained and certified
