5. TENDERING PROCEDURES

5.1. Conditions of Tender and Tender Data

5.1.1. Minimum Prequalification Requirements for: .

Only tenderers who are registered on the National Treasury Central Supplier Database and meet the minimum requirements for the key persons as stipulated in Clause C.2.1 at the tender closing date, are eligible to tender.

Joint Ventures (JV) will be allowed on condition that one JV partner is a Targeted Enterprise. The JV partner will, however, not contribute to sub-contract target for Targeted Enterprises.

5.1.3. Conditions of Tender

It was highlighted that the tender data is based on the standard conditions of tender as contained in Annexure C of the CIDB STANDARD FOR UNIFORMITY IN ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION WORKS CONTRACTS as per Government Notice No. 423 published in Government Gazette No. 42622 of 08 AUGUST 2019 and as amended from time to time. (see www.cidb.org.za)

5.1.4. Tender Data

Any inconsistencies between the Standard conditions and the tender data, the Tender Data takes precedence.

5.1.5. Eligibility Criteria

a) Keypersons

If a tenderer, including key persons, a joint venture partner or a Targeted Enterprise, submits or participates in more than one tender for the same project (SANRAL N.002-230-2025/1F / N.002-240-2021/1F), then all such tenders shall be disqualified (Tender Data C2.13.1)

When a proposed candidate for any position is not in the permanent employ of the tenderer but a contracted person, this must be indicated on form B2 and a <u>signed letter of consent</u> from the candidate must be submitted with the relevant B-forms.

Where a proposed candidate for any position is a permanent staff member of the Tenderer - this must be indicated on form B2, and a <u>signed letter of confirmation</u> must be submitted with the relevant B forms.

b) National Treasury Central Supplier Database (Form A3.4)

Tenderers, or in the event of a joint venture, each member of the joint venture, must be registered on the National Treasury Central Supplier Database at the closing date for tender submissions. If not registered as verified online at tender closing; the tender will be declared non-responsive.

Failure to satisfy the eligibility criteria will result in a non-eligible tender.

5.1.6. Alternative Tender Offers

It was highlighted that alternative offers will not be considered for this tender.

5.1.7. Addenda

5.1.7.1. Issuing of Addenda

The employer shall issue addenda until **ten (10) working** days before tender closing date.

5.1.7.2. Acknowledgement of Addenda

Failure to apply the instructions contained in addenda issued by the Employer may render a Tenderer's offer non-responsive in terms of Condition of Tender C3.8 Test for Responsiveness

5.1.8. Insurance

No insurance is provided by the Employer.

5.1.9. Submission of Tender Offers

5.1.10. Tender Closing Date / Tender Opening

 The closing date/time for submission of tender offers is Tuesday 07 May 2024 at 11h00 am.

5.1.11. Tender Validity Period

It was highlighted to the tenderers that the tender offer validity period is 24 weeks.

5.1.12. Withdrawal of Tender Offers

It was highlighted to the tenderers that should a tenderer at any time after the opening of his tender offer but prior to entering into a contract based on his tender offer:

- withdraw his tender;
- give notice of his inability to execute the contract in terms of his tender; or
- fail to comply with a request made in terms of C.2.17, C.2.18 or C.3.9 of the tender Data,

such tenderer shall be barred from tendering on any of the Employer's tenders for a period to be determined by the Employer, but not less than 6 (six) months from a date determined by the Employer. This sanction also applies to tenders under evaluation and not yet awarded.

5.1.13. Arithmetical errors / Unbalanced rates

In the event of an inconsistency between the amounts in words and the amount in figures, the amount reflected in the Pricing Schedule summary shall govern.

Check responsive tender offers for:

- the gross misplacement of the decimal point in any unit rate;
- omissions made in completing the Pricing Schedule or Bills of Quantities; or
- arithmetic errors in:
 - line item totals resulting from the product of a unit rate and a quantity in Bills of Quantities or Schedules of Prices; or
 - the summation of the prices;
- imbalanced unit rates.

Notify shortlisted tenderers of all errors, omissions or imbalanced rates that are identified in their tender offers and either confirm the tender offers as tendered or accept the corrected total prices.

5.1.14. Eligibility for preference points will be determined as follows:

- 1. A Tenderer's scorecard shall be a B-BBEE Certificate issued in accordance with:
 - the amended Construction Sector Codes published in Notice 931 of 2017 of Government Gazette No. 41287 on 1 December 2017 by the DTI; or
 - in the event that the Measured Entity operates in more than one sector or a subsector, the scorecard for the sector or sub-sector in which the majority of its core activities (measured in terms of annual revenue) are located will be acceptable. The tenderer must comply with the annual revenue thresholds for EME or QSE or Generic in accordance with the amended Construction Sector Codes, and.

2. The scorecard shall be submitted as a certificate attached to Returnable Schedule Form C1.1; and

3.

4. The certificate shall:

- be valid at the tender closing date; and
- have been issued by a verification agency accredited by the SANAS; or
- be in the form of a sworn affidavit or a certificate issued by the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission in the case of an Exempted Micro Enterprise (EME) with a total annual revenue of less than R3 million if issued in accordance with the amended Construction Sector Codes published in Notice 931 of 2017 of Government Gazette No. 41287 on 1 December 2017 by the DTI; and
- have a date of issue less than 12 (twelve) months prior to the original advertised tender closing date (see Tender Data C.2.15); and

5.2 Returnable Schedules

The following was highlighted to the tenderers:

- Signature on each returnable form represents a declaration of the accuracy and correctness of the information provided.
- Failure to fully complete the relevant returnable documents shall render such a tender offer non-responsive.

- All forms must be completed in non-erasable ink and any alterations made prior to tender closure must be countersigned by an authorised signatory.
- In cases of wilful misrepresentation by a tenderer, the Employer shall inform the tenderer and give the tenderer an opportunity to make representations within 14 days as to why the tender submitted should not be disqualified and why the tenderer should not be restricted by the National Treasury from conducting any business with any organ of state for a period not exceeding 10 years. If the Employer has already entered into a contract with the Tenderer, the Employer has the discretionary right under FIDIC to terminate the contract.
- Check returnable documents against Form F1 to ensure the completeness of your tender submission.

Failure to satisfy the eligibility criteria will result in a non-eligible tender.

Only those tenderers who satisfy the following criteria are eligible to submit tenders:

(a) Meet the minimum requirements for the key persons as stated in the Scope of Works in Clause C.3.1.11: Personnel requirements; excluding 3.1.11(f), which is dealt with under Tender Data C.3.13(k).

Registered with Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA) or any other international body recognised by ECSA, i.e. Washington Accord, Dublin Accord and Sydney Accord.

Relevant experience is the actual number of years, measured from the date of acquiring the **base** NQF qualification (either B.Eng / BSc.Eng / B.EngSci or BSc / B.Eng Tech (Hon) PGDip (Engineering) / M.Eng for Pr.Eng or National Higher Diploma / National Diploma Eng / Masters Diploma / BTech / B.Eng Tech / Dip Eng / Adv Dip Eng / Adv Cert (Engineering Practice) plus Adv Dip Eng for Pr.Tech Eng and National Diploma / Dip Eng / Dip Eng Tech / Adv Cert (Engineering Practice) / Higher Certificate (Eng) / Adv Cert (Engineering) / Adv Cert (Engineering Practice) for Pr.Techni Eng), or measured from the date of acquiring the minimum required professional registration worked in the field of the specified position. For the road safety audit team leader, the field shall be road safety design and/or traffic and transportation engineering and/or geometric design.

NB: Failure to meet the stipulated minimum eligibility requirements will render the tender non-responsive.
