# Alex Marquez wins Malaysia **MotoGP race** ahead of Acosta and Mir

Gresini Racing's Alex Marquez won the Malaysian Grand Prix yesterday, finishing ahead of KTM's Pedro Acosta and Honda's Joan Mir, to claim his third victory of the

Marquez, who secured the champi-onship runner-up spot with his sprint re-sults of the security delivers of a faulties ride to Saturdity, delivers of a faulties ride-ternational Circuit adding his two Grand Prix wire in Spain.

Ducati's Francesco Bagnaia, who started on pole and won Saturday's sprint, was forced to retire three laps from the end due to a suspected technical issue while run-ning third, allowing 2020 world champion Mirto claim third place, his second podi-um finish of the year.

Marquez, who had been leading since the second lap, crossed the line 2.676 sec-onds clear of Acosts, and 8.048 seconds ahead of Mir.
