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#### **SCOPE OF WORK**

Eskom seeks to appoint coal suppliers for the supply and delivery of an estimated three hundred million (300 000 000) tons of coal to Eskom's Majuba Power Station for approximately twenty-six (26) years.

#### 1. Coal Quality Specifications

The supplier shall ensure that each quality parameter of the coal delivered to Eskom shall comply with the Quality Specifications set out in column 3 of Table 1 hereunder.

Maintaining the differential of 5.9% between Total moisture of  $\leq$ 10% and inherent Moisture of  $\leq$ 4.1% is essential to consistently convert the CV from Air Dried to As Received basis to meet the As Received CV specification, which is necessary, as the As received CV is what the boiler is subject to.

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- Parameters are measured to 1 (one) decimal place, except AI, HGI and AFT which shall be measured to the nearest integer. Sulphur content and Nitrogen content shall be measured to 2 (two) decimal places.
- The supplier shall ensure that no supplementary ultra-fines are blended into the product and is substantially free from impurities and extraneous materials related to the proper mining and processing of coal.
- Eskom requires coal that is substantially free of contamination and the tenderers shall demonstrate how the offered product will meet this based on their respective mining and/or beneficiation methodology prior to contract award.

#### 2. Mode of Transport

 The mode of transport will be at the discretion of Eskom. Eskom's preferred mode of transport will be conveyor, rail and then road. Eskom reserves the right to decide the preferred mode of transport.

#### 3. Total Cost of Ownership

- The proposal(s) will be considered for its match to Eskom's requirements and due regard given to providing the most optimal solution based on Total Cost of Ownership to Eskom.
- Eskom reserves the right to contract coal for other power stations based on suitability, Total Cost of Ownership and operational needs.

Eskom will afford Tenderers an opportunity to propose additional/alternate offers to the abovementioned. Additional Offers, which are optional, will only be considered if a fully compliant Main Offer is submitted and acceptable.

CPA conditions may apply if the contractual duration is to be longer than 12 months. If the contractual duration will be less than or equal to 12 months, a fixed priced offer must be submitted.

#### 2. TENDER SUBMISSIONS

Tenderers shall comply with the following requirements:

#### a. Main offer:

- 1. A Main Offer that is fully compliant with the CPA requirements as specified in the Enquiry.

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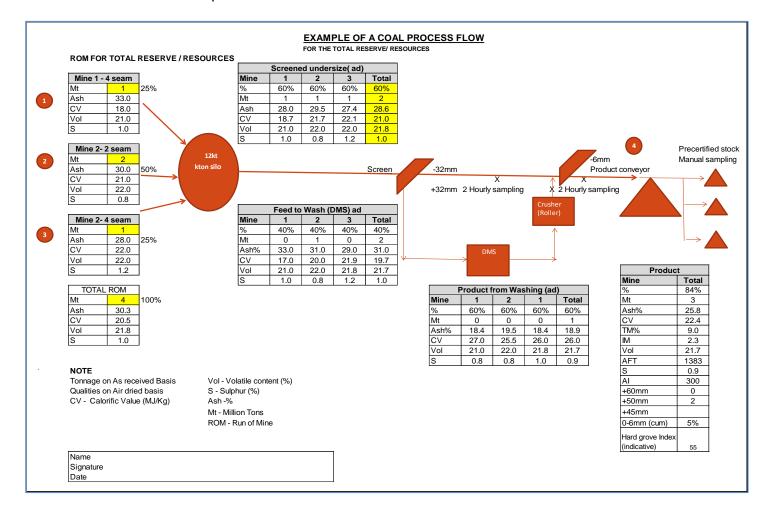
