## **UPGRADING OF AMSTERDAM WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS**

Mkhondo Local Municipality invites bids from suitably qualified Tenderers who meet the prescribed requirements for the UPGRADING OF AMSTERDAM WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS (Civil, Mechanical and Electrical works). It is estimated that tenderers must have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 7CE or Higher.

Bid documents may be purchased from the Cashiers at the Municipality in Mkhondo and Amsterdam Satellite office, Mpumalanga from the 24<sup>th</sup> of November 2025 between 09:00am-15:30pm, Monday to Friday for non-refundable fee of R 1 500.00 (Cash/Card Payment) no documents will be couriered to prospective bidders.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at Amsterdam Town Hall (Municipal Offices) on the 24<sup>th</sup> of November 2025 starting at 10h00.

Tenders are to be completed in black ink and completed in accordance with the conditions and rules contained in the tender document. The tenders and relevant documents must be sealed in an envelope and externally endorsed with the description: MKHO14/2025/26, UPGRADING OF AMASTERDAM WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS and be deposited in the Tender Box, Mkhondo Local Municipality, Corner of Mark and De Wet Streets, Mkhondo, Mpumalanga not later than 12h00 on 18<sup>th</sup> of DECEMBER 2025. The Tenders shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the closing date. Telegraphic, telephonic, fax, telex e-mail or late tenders will not be accepted. When submitting tender documents, bidders are mandated to write their name, name of the companies their submitting for, clear contact details and e-mail address of the bidder on the correct submission register failure which your bids may not be considered for adjudication.

Please take note that no bid documents will be given to couriers unless the courier company is in the possession of a letter on the official letterhead, confirming on behalf of the company the full details of the specific bid/bids to be collected and payment of the full amount payable for the bids is required. The Council reserves the right to either accept the whole or part of any bid, or not to appoint. Facsimiles or e-mailed documents will not be accepted. No awards will be made to a person who:

• Is in the service of the state, If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state, Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

Tenders will be evaluated in terms of the Supply Chain Management policy of the Mkhondo Local Municipality. The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted, and Mkhondo Local Municipality reserves the right not to consider any tender not suitably endorsed or comprehensively completed, as well as the right to accept the tender in whole or part. Service Providers must be registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD). Tenders must only be submitted on the tender documentation that is issued. Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

The following compulsory documents must be accompanied with the tender, and failure to provide such documentations shall constitute automatic disqualification: Proof of valid CIDB Grading Designation of the bidder, Valid SARS Tax Compliance Status Pin (TCS Pin), Valid Letter of Good Standing, copy of Company Registration Certificate (CIPC), Current (for the month ended November 2025) Municipal Account/Valid Lease agreement for both the entity and its Directors,

certified copy of shareholder's ID documents, Comprehensive (Not a Summary) CSD Registration Report (not older than thirty days from tender closing date), Entity's latest three-year Audited Annual Financial Statements (in comparative years).

Corporate Social Investment: Bidders are mandated to make a provision for corporate social investment (CSI) at 1% as part of the municipality's empowerment program implemented through it's Supply Chain Management Policy when allocated work.

All submissions will be adjudicated in terms of the Mkhondo Local Municipality's Procurement Policy, the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 as well as the preferential procurement regulations, 2022 (PPR 2022). The 80/20 Price and Specific goals Point System will be applicable for this tender. Method 2 of evaluation of the acceptable proposals will be applied and responsive bids are expected to score at least a minimum of 75 % (60 out of 80 points) for Quality to be considered for further evaluation.
