The purpose of this Notice is to provide additional information on the below:

1. Non-Compulsory Clarification Meeting – Answers to Questions regarding the preference points.

When claiming preference points, there is no indication of the supporting documents required for submission (e.g. B-BBEE certificate, etc.). Please advise which supporting documents must accompany the tender submission to score preference points. Furthermore, please advise if there are any specific submission requirements for Joint Ventures, e.g. a consolidated JV certificate	The supporting documents required to claim preference points are those specified on page 151 under "notes" in the tender document. These must be submitted to substantiate each claim. Bidders must ensure that the relevant tables within Schedule F.24 is signed and completed as required. Bidders must provide proof of the specific goal claimed, as stipulated in the tender document. Where the tendering entity is a JV: • The JV is regarded as the bidder. • Supporting documentation must be submitted to substantiate the specific goals claimed, in accordance with the tender requirements. • Only documentation specified in the tender will be considered for the allocation of preference points, refer to page 151
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If a bidder is not a micro or small enterprise, but their appointed sub-consultant is a micro or small enterprise, can the bidder claim preference points? If yes, what are the requirements for claiming point	Yes, a bidder may claim preference points where a qualifying micro or small enterprise participates through subcontracting, partnership, or similar arrangements. Such claims are only permissible where the tender document provides for SME participation to be considered as part of the evaluation criteria To claim points, the bidder must submit: • Details of the participating enterprise; • Proof that the participating enterprise meets the required turnover thresholds; and • Supporting documents (e.g. financial statements and B-BBEE documentation, where applicable). Preference points will only be awarded where sufficient supporting evidence is provided.
