#### 1. INTRODUCTION

- f. **Operational Track Record**: Have been in operation for a minimum of two years.
- g. **Business Plan**: Provide a credible plan showcasing growth, sustainability, and alignment with Eskom's localisation objectives.
- h. **Economic Impact**: Illustrate potential local economic benefits such as job creation, skills development, and increased local content.
- i. **Transformation Commitment**: Encourage participation by B-BBEE status at Level 1 or Level 2 black-owned SMMEs to promote transformation and inclusivity.
