# **Annex C:** RFQ SPECIFICATION

#### 1. BACKGROUND TO THE ROAD ACCIDENT FUND

The Road Accident Fund (RAF) is a schedule 3A Public Entity established in terms of the Road Accident Fund Act, 1996 (Act No. 56 of 1996), as amended. Its mandate is the provision of compulsory social insurance cover to all users of South African roads, to rehabilitate and compensate persons injured as a result of the negligent driving of motor vehicles in a timely and caring manner, and to actively promote the safe use of our roads. The RAF has its headquarters in Centurion - Pretoria and other offices country wide.

#### 2. BACKGROUND OF THE PROJECT

The Road Accident Fund (RAF) wishes to appoint a service provider to provide forensic engineering services for the Cape Town office.

#### 3. DETAILED SPECIFICATION

Our office require the appointment of an independent expert to inspect a vehicle to advise if the vehicle is considered a motor vehicle.

The engineering expert should do the following:

- 1. Physically inspect the vehicle that was used at the time of the accident, to establish whether or not it meets the requirements in terms of the Act and established Case Law (ascertain whether the vehicle was equipped with safety belts, indicators, hooter, reverse gear, all necessary lights like headlights, park lights, taillights, brake lights, hazard "flashing" lights at the time of accident)
- 2. Interview the driver / owner of the vehicle and ascertain whether he was involved in the construction of the vehicle. Whether the vehvcile was used on public, tarred roads other than the gravel road the accident occurred on?
- 3. Whether the vehicle was registered with the traffic authorities as being roadworthy
- 4. Last known address of vehicle: Kuruman, Northern Cape (additional information will be shared with the preferred bidder)
- 5. Submit report and all other relevant documents
