### **REJECTION OF BID**

Bids which do not comply with the Contract in all aspects may be rejected

### **BID ACCEPTANCE**

The lowest or any bid will not necessarily be accepted and the full or portion of any bid may be accepted.

### **PRICES**

The bidded prices shall compromise all costs, inclusive of, administrative, transport and delivery costs.

It is a condition of this contract that the price quoted shall be firm for orders placed within the full duration of the contract and no representations for price adjustment will be considered during this period.

All bided prices shall be inclusive of Value Added Tax.

The bidded prices shall not be linked to the exchange rate between the SA Rand and any other currency.


