T1.1 TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER (SBD1)

The South African National Roads Agency SOC Limited (SANRAL) invites tenders for the Routine Road Maintenance of Electrical Lighting Infrastructure on National Route **N2 Section 21x To Section 26 - Package 1 (Non-Toll)** in the various District municipalities. This project is in the province of **Kwazulu-Natal** and in the Harry Gwala, Ugu and eThekweni Metropolitan District Municipalities. The duration is **Sixty (60) Months**. CIDB Regulation 25 (1B) will be applicable to this contract.

Only tenderers with a B-BBEE contributor status level of 1, 2, 3 or 4, and QSE; who are registered on the National Treasury Central Supplier Database at the tender closing date; and meet the stipulated minimum threshold for local content and production as stated in the Tender Data are eligible to tender.

It is estimated that tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of **7EP** or higher, however tenderers attention is drawn to clause C.2.1 of the Tender Data when submitting their tender.

Tenders from tenderers registered as potentially emerging enterprises but with a CIDB contractor grading designation lower than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered, or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25(1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, will not be accepted.

This tender includes the following compulsory subcontracting to Targeted Enterprises as in the Part C4, section D.

The tenderer must meet the minimum threshold designated for local production and content as stated in the Tender Data C.2.1
