## **DETAILED TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION**

### **1. BACKGROUND**

The SABC KZN office needs a gate and door accredited service provider, who will ensure that preventative maintenance, is carried out on all industrial roller doors, motorized doors and sliding gates. The automated sliding gates are connected to the access control system and are the main access points to the SABC premises. The industrial roller doors are operated by a switch and will also need regular maintenance to prolong their lifespan. The purpose of the preventative maintenance is to check that the safety features are working correctly to reduce breakdowns.

### **2. SCOPE OF WORK**

2.1 The preventative maintenance will need to be performed at two intervals, including one major service. On each service, a full inspection of the systems is expected to be carried out, inclusive of a full repair coverage on all necessary parts. Maintenance service to be rendered during normal working hours. Replaced parts to be of the same brand or equivalent. Emergency breakdown service to be covered with 1 hour breakdown response

**The successful service provider will be expected to comply with SABC health and safety regulations**

The gates are linked to the access control system and are the main point of exit and Entrance to the SABC site. All roller shutter doors at the TVOB are operated by a switch

Gates:

- Major Service of the gate motor
- Check the gate tracks.
- Check the gate wheels, bearings and replace if worn out
- Lubricate parts where required.
- Provide and apply paint once per annum
- Check and weld loose panels if necessary.
- Check the batteries and charger if they are fully functional, repair or replaced if required.
- The service provider will be expected to replace all the parts and components as necessary.

Roller shutter doors:

- Servicing of the motor and all moving parts including replacement if necessary
- Remove old grease, re-apply new grease on the tracks and the roller door frame needs be stable

- Cleaning of doors to remove dust and sludge
- Check the batteries and all electrical parts and replace if necessary
- Check all securing bolts if they are tightly fitted and replace faulty ones if necessary
- Check all connections and switches for defects and replace if required.
- Inspect and service shaft, bearings, and springs

Motorized sliding doors:

- Service of the motor and all moving parts including replacement if necessary
- Check the batteries and replace if necessary
- Check the tension belts
- Check the wheel track
- Check the functionality of the sensor

Treatment of rust on all gates and roller shutter doors including electrical connections.  
Service provider shall provide the warranty on all replaced part and service rendered

### 3. **CONTRACT DOCUMENTATION**

3.1. A contract is for a period of five (5) years based on a CPI escalation per annum.

### 4. **LOCATION OF SITE**

4.1. **The Contract site is at SABC Durban, KZN**

### 5. ***RFQ Response Information***

**Effective Date of Bid**

Vendor(s) should state in their offer to the SABC in writing that all information, including price, provided shall remain valid and applicable for 90 days from the date the SABC receives the vendor quotation.

### 6. **COSTING**

The quotation must reflect a detailed cost breakdown, and any indirect costs with the rendering of the service.

## 7. CONTRACT WORKS AREA

**7.1** The Contractor shall confine his activities to the Contract Works site and the access route to this site.

**7.2** A list of names of working staff and ID proof will be submitted to the SABC. Workers will wear clothing clearly identifying the identity of the supplier.

**7.3** The site area is inside a broadcasting environment; therefore, care should be taken to reduce noise and dust when executing the work

## 8. EVALUATION CRITERIA

### 8.1. **BBBEE and Price**

- The RFQ responses will be evaluated on the 80/20-point system.

### 8.2. **Technical Evaluation**

- The tender submission will be technically evaluated out of a maximum of **50**.
- A threshold of **50** out of the **100** has been set.
- All bidders achieving less than the set threshold will be declared non-responsive.

### 8.3. **Objective Criteria**

- SABC further reserve the right not to award this RFQ to any bidder based on the proven poor record of accomplishment of the bidder in previous projects within the SABC.

## 9. ADJUDICATION USING A POINT SYSTEM



- 9.1. The bidder obtaining the highest number of total points will be awarded the contract unless objective criteria justify the award to another bidder.
- 9.2. Preference points shall be calculated after process has been brought to a comparative basis considering all factors of non-firm prices.
- 9.3. In the event that two or more bids have scored equal points, the successful bid must be the one scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.
- 9.4. However, when functionality is part of the evaluation process and two or more bids have scored equal points for B-BBEE, the successful bid must be the one scoring the highest score for functionality.
- 9.5. Should two or more bids be equal in all respect, the award shall be decided by the drawing of lots.

## 10. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

The **80/20** preference point system

A maximum of **80** points is allocated for price on the following basis:

- 10.1. Bidders who qualify as EME's in terms of the B-BBEE Act must submit a certificate issued by a verification Agency accredited by SANAS for the purpose of conducting verification and issuing EMEs with B-BBEE Status Level Certificates or DTI Affidavit.

- 10.2. Bidders other than EMEs must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status levels verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a verification agency accredited by SANAS.
- 10.3. A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as a legal entity, provided that the entity submits their B-BBEE status level certificate.
- 10.4. A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as an unincorporated entity, provided that the entity submits their consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure and that such a consolidated B-BBEE scorecard is prepared for every separate bid.
- 10.5. Tertiary institutions and public entities will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level certificates in terms of the specialized scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.
- 10.6. A tenderer will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the bid documents that such a bidder intends sub-contracting more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the points that such a bidder qualifies for, unless the intended Sub-contractor is an EME that has the capacity and the ability to execute the sub-contract.
- 10.7. A tenderer awarded a contract may not sub-contract more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned, unless the contract is sub-contracted to an EME that has the capacity and the ability to execute the sub-contract.

## **11. COMMUNICATION**

Respondents are warned that a response will be disqualified should any attempt be made by a tenderer either directly or indirectly to canvass any officer(s) or employees of SABC in respect of a tender, between the closing date and the date of the award of the business.

All enquiries relating to this RFQ should be emailed three days before the closing date.

## **12. CONDITIONS TO BE OBSERVED WHEN TENDERING**

- 12.1. The Corporation does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender, nor shall it be responsible for or pay any expenses or losses which may be incurred by the Tenderer in the preparation and delivery of his tender. The Corporation reserves the right to accept a separate tender or separate tenders for any one or more of the

sections of a specification. The corporation also reserves the right to withdraw the tender at any stage.

12.2. No tender shall be deemed to have been accepted unless and until a formal contract / letter of intent is prepared and executed.

12.3. The Corporation reserves the right to:

**Not evaluate and award submissions that do not comply with his RFQ document.**

**Make a selection solely on the information received in the submissions and**

12.3.1. Enter into negotiations with any one or more of preferred bidder(s) based on the criteria specified in the evaluation of this tender.

12.3.2. Contact any bidder during the evaluation process, in order to clarify any information, without informing any other bidders. During the evaluation process, no change in the content of the RFQ shall be sought, offered, or permitted.

12.3.3. Award a contract to one or more bidder(s).

12.3.4. Accept any tender in part or full at its own discretion.

12.3.5. Cancel this RFQ or any part thereof at any time.

12.3.6. Should a bidder(s) be selected for further negotiations, they will be chosen on the basis of the greatest benefit to the Corporation and not necessarily on the basis of the lowest costs, aligned to the BBBEE & Preference Point system.

### **13. Cost of Bidding**

The Tenderer shall bear all costs and expenses associated with preparation and submission of its tender or RFQ, and the Corporation shall under no circumstances be responsible or liable for any such costs, regardless of, without limitation, the conduct or outcome of the bidding, evaluation, and selection process.

### **14. PAYMENT TERMS**

SABC will effect payment sixty (60) days after the service provider has submitted an invoice.

## **ANNEXURE "D"**

### **SBD 9 CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION**

- 1 This Standard Bidding Document (SBD) must form part of all bids<sup>1</sup> invited.
- 2 Section 4 (1) (b) (iii) of the Competition Act No. 89 of 1998, as amended, prohibits an agreement between, or concerted practice by, firms, or a decision by an association of firms, if it is between parties in a horizontal relationship and if it involves collusive bidding (or bid rigging).<sup>2</sup> Collusive bidding is a *pe se* prohibition meaning that it cannot be justified under any grounds.
- 3 Treasury Regulation 16A9 prescribes that accounting officers and accounting authorities must take all reasonable steps to prevent abuse of the supply chain management system and authorizes accounting officers and accounting authorities to:
  - a. disregard the bid of any bidder if that bidder, or any of its directors have abused the institution's supply chain management system and or committed fraud or any other improper conduct in relation to such system.
