Specification for the service provider to procure Live Simulcasts on Community Radio Stations on the COVID-19 SRD Grant and other SASSA Grants

1. Purpose

To request procurement for Live Simulcast Broadcasts on Community Radio Stations in all nine provinces.

2. Scope of Work

- 2.1 The service provider for the procurement of:
 - 2.1.1 Live Simulcasts on Community Radio Stations on the COVID-19 SRD Grant and other SASSA Grants on community Radio Stations with the following:
 - 5-10 minutes pre- recorded messages, three times a day(Morning, Midday and afternoon) for 4 months(December 2022- March 2023)
 - 30 minutes live simulcast once a month for 4 months(December 2022-March 2023
 - 2.1.2 The broadcasting must cover all districts per province to address issues of concern regarding COVID-19 SRD Grant and other grants related information.

2.2. Services or works the service provider is expected to provide

In addition to the above scope of work, the service provider will be expected to do the production of the messages to be broadcasted.

3. Expected Deliverables

- 3.1. Media bulk buying
- Procure media slots in accordance with the schedule provided
- Facilitate the broadcasting of the SASSA live reads advertisements on community radios for 4 months
- Facilitate the broadcasting of SASSA live simulcast once a month for 4 months
- Provide SASSA with a broadcasting schedule of the advertisements on media campaign

 Provide a closeout report in terms of coverage, listenership and impact of the campaign

3.2 Media Production

- Facilitate the production(script; voice over and recording) of the 5-10 minutes prerecorded messages in all 11 official languages
- Edit scripts provided by SASSA for the live simulcast
- Provide x4 podcasts of live simulcast provided

4 Knowledge and Experience

- 4.1. The service provider must have a database of all community radio stations in the country
- 4.2. The service provider must have provided the media buying and production service to 2 or more public or private entities. Letters of reference must be attached
- 4.3. The service provider must have experience working with both community or commercial radio stations

- 1.6 The purchaser reserves the right to require of a bidder, either before a bid is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the purchaser.

- (c) "bid" means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the provision of goods or services, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;
