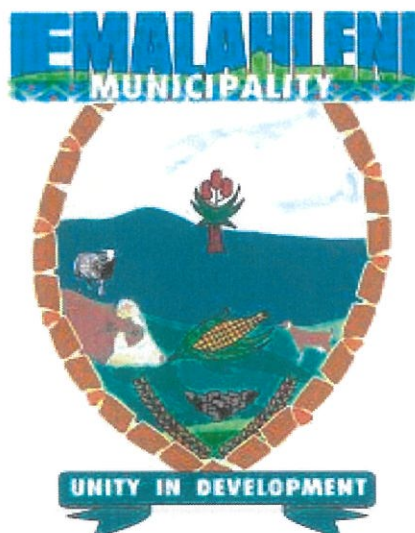

PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT (PPPFA) POINTS WILL BE AWARDED AS FOLLOWS:

Price	- 80 points
BBBEE	- 20 points
Total	-100 points

Bidders shall take note of the following bid conditions:

- Bidders will be adjudicated in accordance with the Municipality Supply Chain Management Policy and in terms of Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act new regulations of 2017 and will be based on the 80/20 points system.
- Canvassing of municipal staff or councillors will automatically disqualify any tender
- Quotes are to hold good for a period of 30 days
- Submit a company registration certificate (C.K document).
- Tax Compliance Status (TCS) Pin must be supplied with the tender or the tender will not be considered and in case of a JV, Tax Compliance Status (TCS) Pins for both companies must be submitted.
- All prices must include 15% VAT
- Proof of registration with the CIDB must accompany the completed tender document or the tender will not be considered. In case of a JV, proof of registrations with the CIDB for both companies must be submitted.
- The procedure for the evaluation will be in three stage, Stage 1 will be compliance, Stage 2 will be the functionality and Stage 3 will be price and preference point system.
- Submit all director's certified ID copies as reflecting on the company registration document.
- Submit a certified copy or an original BBBEE status level Certificate/or an original sworn affidavit in terms of the Amended B-BBBE codes.
- Submit proof of registration summary on Central Supplier Database (CSD).
- All municipal rates and taxes of the supplier must be paid where the business has its head or regional office. Latest billing clearance certificate or account statement not older than 3 months must be submitted with the bid, or if the property is being leased then lease agreement must be attached, failure to do so will result in the bid being disqualified. **NB** the billing clearance certificate is only applicable to

- bidders who operate their business in an area or property that is not billed by the municipality.
- **Bidders to submit minimum bank rating of C.**
- The following Municipal Bid Documents are compulsory documents and must be completed in full and included in the tender document:
 - MBD 1(Compulsory)
 - MBD 3.1 (Compulsory)
 - MBD 4(Compulsory for all shareholders and or directors.)
 - MBD 6.1(Compulsory)
 - MBD 6.2 (Compulsory to be fully completed) – Declaration certificate for local content and production to be completed by the Tenderer. The successful tenderer will be requested to submit a letter from the Manufacturer to confirm 100% local production of steel products and components.
 - MBD 8(Compulsory)
 - MBD 9(Compulsory)
- All certified documents must not be older than three (03) months.
- All other pre-requisites as detailed in the bid documents shall apply.
- Failure to complete all the supplementary information will result in bidder being deemed non-responsive.



