2	<p>Please confirm how old should the proof of registration with the relevant Legal Practice Council be - (Administrative and Substantive Responsiveness).</p>	<p>The proof of registration with the LPC should not be older than 24 months.</p>
3	<p>Kindly see attached page 21 of the ACSA RFP, please advise how we are to complete such pricing schedule if the schedule is already completed in the tender.</p>	<p>You must create your own schedule for the resources set out in the proposed tariff and include your proposed price</p>
