Only Tenderers that meet the following pre-qualification conditions may respond:

- Bidder's must be registered with both CIDB and on the central suppliers database (CSD). It is envisaged that a minimum CIDB contractor grading of **4EP** is required for this project.
- A Bidder must have a current and valid Electrical Contractor's registration with the Department of Labourer and shall remain registered for the duration of the contract.
- It is a requirement that the bidder shall have in his / her employ a suitably qualified staff member, or alternatively can appoint an Accredited Agent, that can manage and implement the requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations.
- A Bidder must have successfully completed a minimum of three projects each pertaining to both MV (up to 22kV) and LV
 overhead and underground reticulation within the last five years, and to have in their employ a suitably qualified person
 certified to perform heat shrink type MV joints / terminations.

Prospective Bidders must note that the local production and content requirements for designated sectors, as stipulated in the Preferential Procurement Regulations made in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 5 of 2000, will apply to this tender, for the following products:

- Electrical and telecom cables 90%
- Transformers and Shunt Reactors (Class 1) 70%
- Residential Electricity Meters 70%
- Powerline Hardware 100%
- Steel Value-added Products 100%

Tenders will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2000), The Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 and the Hessequa Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy, for which 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of B-BBEE contribution.

Sealed tenders, appropriately marked with the contract number, must be placed in the tender box at the offices of **Hessequa Municipality**, **Post Office Building**, **19 Main Road**, **Riversdale**, **before or at 12h00 on Friday**, **02 DECEMBER 2022**, after which tenders will be opened.

Electronic format of tenders or faxes will not be accepted, and incomplete tenders and / or tenders received late will not be considered. The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and / or re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

Preferences may be offered to tenderers who are registered on the Municipality's Accredited Suppliers Database. The Municipality reserves the right not to award tenders to prospective suppliers who are not registered on the Database.
