1.2 DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAMME

The Independent Development Trust (IDT), listed in terms of the Public Finance Management

Act (PFMA) as a Schedule 2 entity that is mandated to provide social infrastructure delivery

management services as a contribution to the national development agenda. The entity

delivers social infrastructure through a participatory approach leaning towards people-

centeredness and incorporates the empowerment of historically vulnerable groups' in its

development efforts and performance indicators.

The IDT is implementing a Contractor Development Programme (CDP in order to build and

enhance the capacity of the construction industry. The programme entails recruiting

emerging contractors amongst the previously disadvantaged South Africans,

facilitating theoretical training and extensive practical infrastructure development

mentorship process. The aim is to support lower graded contractors to enable them to

grow to achieve the necessary competences, experience, track record and financial

capital in order to be upgraded in the construction industry.

#### 4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

- 4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For this tender, the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in Table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
  - (a) an invitation for tender for income-generating contracts, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the highest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system; or
