1.2 Additional Specifications

To become a legally recognised driving instructor in South Africa, you must be **registered with the Provincial department of Transport**. Driving instructors are required to have a **certificate specifying the grade or the class of vehicle** in which they are qualified to instruct learners.

Instructors will deal only with the class of motor vehicles for which you are licenced.

Provider is responsible for **all course material/equipment** such as data projector, laptop, etc. and other consumables e.g. flipchart paper, pens, note books etc.

Venue to be arranged by the Service Provider, Note that the CoCT must approve the location and suitability of the training venue prior to the commencement of the training.
