#### 2 PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

Transnet has implemented a new electronic tender submission system, the e-Tender Submission Portal, in line with the overall Transnet digitalization strategy where suppliers can view advertised tenders, register their information, log their intent to respond to bids and upload their bid proposals/responses on to the system.

- a) The Transnet e-Tender Submission Portal can be accessed as follows:

  - b) Click on "ADVERTISED TENDERS" to view advertised tenders;
  - c) Click on "SIGN IN/REGISTER –to register new bidder information and ensure that all mandatory information is completed) OR;

  - e) Toggle (click to switch) the "Log an Intent" button to submit a bid;
  - f) Submit bid documents by uploading them into the system against each tender selected.

#### 3 RFP INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Please sign documents [sign, stamp and date the bottom of each page] before uploading them on the system. The person or persons signing the submission must be legally authorised by the respondent to do so.
- 3.2 All returnable documents tabled in the Proposal Form [Section 5] must be returned with proposals.
- 3.3 Unless otherwise expressly stated, all Proposals furnished pursuant to this RFP shall be deemed to be offers. Any exceptions to this statement must be clearly and specifically indicated.

3.4 Any additional conditions must be embodied in an accompanying letter. Subject only to clause 15 [Alterations made by the Respondent to Bid Prices] of the General Bid Conditions, paragraph 12 below (Legal Review) and Section 6 of the RFP, alterations, additions or deletions must not be made by the Respondent to the actual RFP documents.

#### 4 JOINT VENTURES OR CONSORTIUMS

Respondents who would wish to respond to this RFP as a Joint Venture [JV] or consortium with B-BBEE entities, must state their intention to do so in their RFP submission. Such Respondents must also submit a signed JV or consortium agreement between the parties clearly stating the percentage [%] split of business and the associated responsibilities of each party. If at the time of the bid submission such a JV or consortium agreement has not been concluded, the partners must submit confirmation in writing of their intention to enter into a JV or consortium agreement should they be awarded business by Transnet through this RFP process. This written confirmation must clearly indicate the percentage [%] split of business and the responsibilities of each party. In such cases, award of business will only take place once a signed copy of a JV or consortium agreement is submitted to Transnet.

Respondents are to note that for the purpose of Evaluation, a JV will be evaluated based on one consolidated B-BBEE score card (a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level verification certificate) Preference points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the specific goals requirements in accordance with the table indicated in Section 4.1 of the specific goals Claim Form.

- 4.5 It is prohibited for Respondents to attempt, either directly or indirectly, to canvass any officer or employee of Transnet in respect of this RFP between the closing date and the date of the award of the business.
- 4.6 Respondents found to be in collusion with one another will be automatically disqualified and restricted from doing business with organs of state for a specified period.
- 4.7 Transnet will publish the outcome of this RFP in the National Treasury e-tender portal and Transnet website with 10 days after the award has been finalised. Respondents are required to check the National Treasury e-tender Portal and Transnet website for the results of the tender process. All unsuccessful

#### 6 COMPLIANCE

The successful Respondent [hereinafter referred to as the [**Supplier**] shall be in full and complete compliance with any and all applicable laws and regulations.

#### 7 EMPLOYMENT EQUITY ACT

Respondents must comply with the requirements of the Employment Equity Act 55 of 1998 applicable to it including (but not limited to) Section 53 of the Employment Equity Act.

#### 8 DISCLAIMERS

Respondents are hereby advised that Transnet is not committed to any course of action as a result of its issuance of this RFP and/or its receipt of Proposals. In particular, please note that Transnet reserves the right to:

- 8.1 modify the RFP's Goods/Services;
- 8.2 award a contract in connection with this Proposal at any time after the RFP's closing date;
- 8.3 award a contract for only a portion of the proposed Goods/Services which are reflected in the scope of this RFP;
- split the award of the contract between more than one Supplier/Service provider, as may be explicitly articulated in the conditions or objective criteria to this RFP;
- 8.5 cancel the bid process;
- 8.6 validate any information submitted by Respondents in response to this bid. This would include, but is not limited to, requesting the Respondents to provide supporting evidence. By submitting a bid, Respondents hereby irrevocably grant the necessary consent to Transnet to do so;
- 8.7 request audited financial statements or other documentation for the purposes of a due diligence exercise;

#### **SECTION 3: BACKGROUND, OVERVIEW AND SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS**

#### 1 BACKGROUND

Transnet Rail Infrastructure Manager requires earthmoving plant to excavate, backfill, grade the aggregate material, transport and any other function needed on a construction site. The plant helps to accelerate the rate of execution, ensuring it is safely executed.

#### 2 **EXECUTIVE OVERVIEW**

Whereas Transnet is seeking to improve its current process for providing these Goods/Services to its end users community throughout the prescribed locations.

The selected Suppliers/Service provider(s) must share in the mission and business objectives of Transnet. These mutual goals will be met by meeting contractual requirements and new challenges in an environment of teamwork, joint participation, flexibility, innovation and open communications. In this spirt of partnership, Transnet and its Suppliers/Service provider(s) will study the current way they do business to enhance current practices and support processes and systems. Such a partnership will allow Transnet to reach higher levels of quality, service and profitability.

Specifically, Transnet seeks to benefit from this partnership in the following ways:

- 2.1 Transnet must receive reduced cost of acquisition and improved services benefits resulting from the Supplier/Service provider's economics of scale and streamlined service processes.
- 2.2 Transnet must achieve appropriate availability that meets users needs while reducing costs for both Transnet and chosen Supplier/Service provider(s).
- 2.3 Transnet must receive proactive improvements from Supplier/Service provider with respect to supply/provision of Goods and Services and related processes.
- 2.4 Transnet's overall competitive advantages must be strengthened by the chosen Supplier/Service provider's leading-edge technology and service delivery systems.
- 2.5 Transnet end users must be able to reply on the chosen Supplier/Service provider's personnel for service enquires, recommendations and substitutions.
- 2.6 Transnet must reduce costs by streamlining its acquisitions of Good/Services, including managed service processes on a Group basis.

#### 3 SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

TRIM seeks to appoint a supplier to supply Plant for Formation Rehabilitation between De Aar to Bletterman, on the De Aar – Port Elizabeth line. The preferred bidder will be required to supply and deliver the earthmoving machinery to km 1.000 in the De Aar yard, 30°40′01.9″S,24°00′58.0″E. A successful bidder will be required to meet the following requirements:

- 2.3.1 The successful bidder is required to supply, operate and maintain the Earth Moving Plant for the hired duration.
- 2.3.2 The successful bidder must have immediate availability of Earth Moving Plant to start work as and when required.

- 2.3.3 The successful bidder must ensure that his/her operators and personnel are trained and certified to execute the work.
- 2.3.4 The successful bidder shall submit proof that the operators are certified competent. The lifting gear must be certified and comply with Transnet Code of Practice No.29.
- 2.3.5 The successful bidder shall comply with the TRIM's health and safety plans.
- 2.3.6 The successful bidder shall complete in respect of each day a daily activity report which reports on staff deployed, the activities which they are carrying out and any unusual occurrences such as interruptions, delays, conflicting instructions, strikes, accidents and the like. The successful contractor shall furnish TRIM with reports, unless otherwise specified, on a monthly basis.

#### 4 IMPORTANT CLARIFICATION TO BIDDERS



#### 7.4 STEP Four: Price Negotiations

Respondents are to note that Transnet may not award a contract if the price offered is not market related. In this regard, Transnet reserves the right to engage in PTN with the view to achieving a market-related price or to cancel the tender. Negotiations will be done in a sequential manner i.e.:
