#### 5.3 FUNCTIONALITY EVALUATION

As part of the quality criteria, Bidders shall further be required to satisfy the following functionality criteria and be required to demonstrate their ability to undertake the work and to provide proof of experience, qualifications and expertise to undertake work of this nature.

Bidders are required to score a minimum of 8 points out of a possible 10 points (i.e. 80 %) in order to be responsive:

Bidders who fail to meet the minimum threshold shall be declared non-responsive and subsequently rejected. Where insufficient information is provided, zero points will be awarded for such particular criterion. Ratio for Quality & Price Offer: 80:20.

SANParks reserves the right not to award to the highest points scorer in accordance with S 2(1) (f) of the Act (PPPFA).

- (j) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
