

19. The tenderer shall, when requested by the Employer to do so, submit the names of all management and supervisory staff that will be employed to supervise the Labour Intensive portion of the works together with satisfactory evidence that such staff members satisfy the eligibility requirements.
20. The Northern Cape Provincial Supply Chain Management Procurement Policy Framework, approved in December 2018, States that the Provincial Departments must at least spend 60% of their procurement budget on Designated Groups within the province. The Department Reserves the right to award contracts based on the above mentioned framework policy
- 21. On completion of phase 2** of the Ganspan Sub-surface Drainage Mainline, the system must be tested by the contractor in the presence of the project leader and beneficiaries.
22. Pricing must include all Transport and Labour required to complete the works successfully.
23. All critical height level points and coordinates on drawing must be confirmed and acknowledge on site. This must be confirmed before commencing with any construction of a permanent nature.
24. Proof of minimum qualifications (certificate/diploma and two years proven experience) of the surveyor to be used during the duration of the project, is required to be submitted with this bid document. Failure to submit would lead to disqualification.
25. The verifying of all wayleaf approvals are still valid an in order e.g. eskom, public works, municipalities etc. |
