Each wagon consists of 3x separate barrels, provide the dimensions of each barrel i.e, diameter, length, thickness	- XB 5: 2 x Barrel, ID 1972 mm, L : 5634 mm, T: 6.35 mm - XB 8 & 9: 4 x Barrel, ID: 2133 mm, L: 3743 mm, T : 5 mm - XB 10: 2x Barrel, ID: 2106 mm, L: 4302 mm, T: 10 mm - XB 11 & 12 : 3 x Barrel, ID: 2950 mm, L : 3770 mm, T : 5 mm - XB 13 & 14: 3 x Barrel, ID:3038 mm, L: 3965, T: 5 mm
Estimated quantities = 580 wagons, meaning that there are a total of 1740 barrels	140 wagons per year
