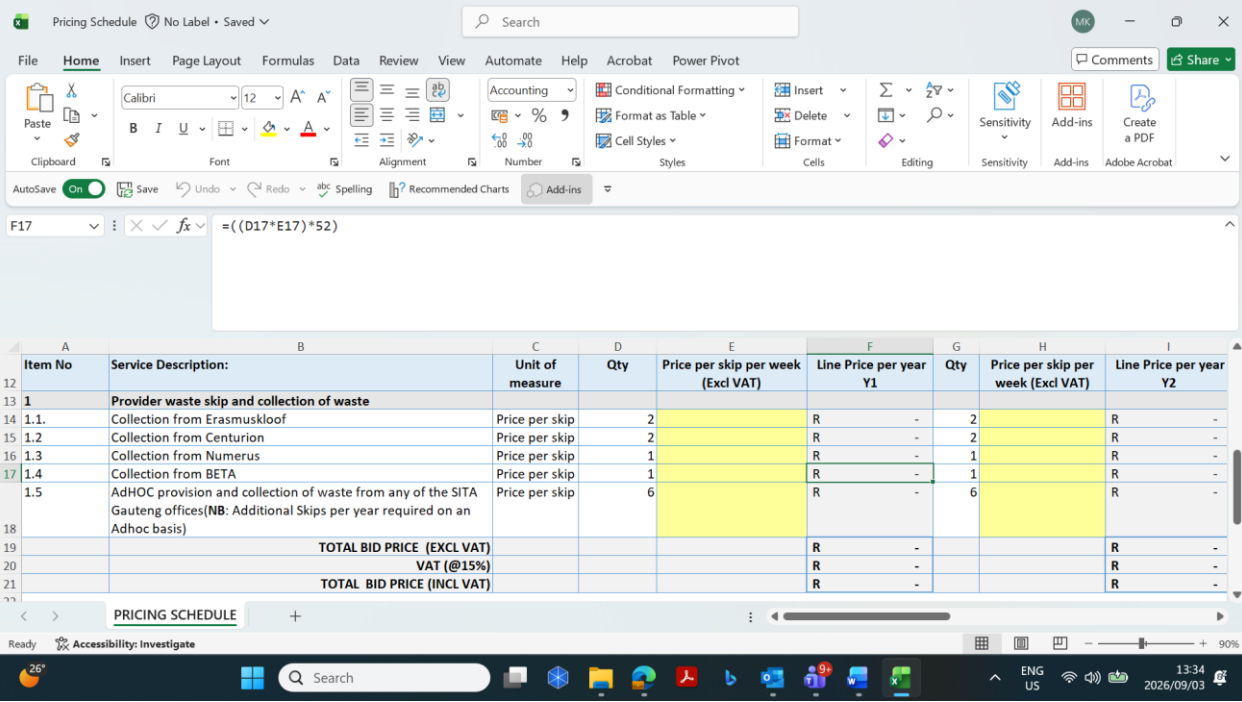
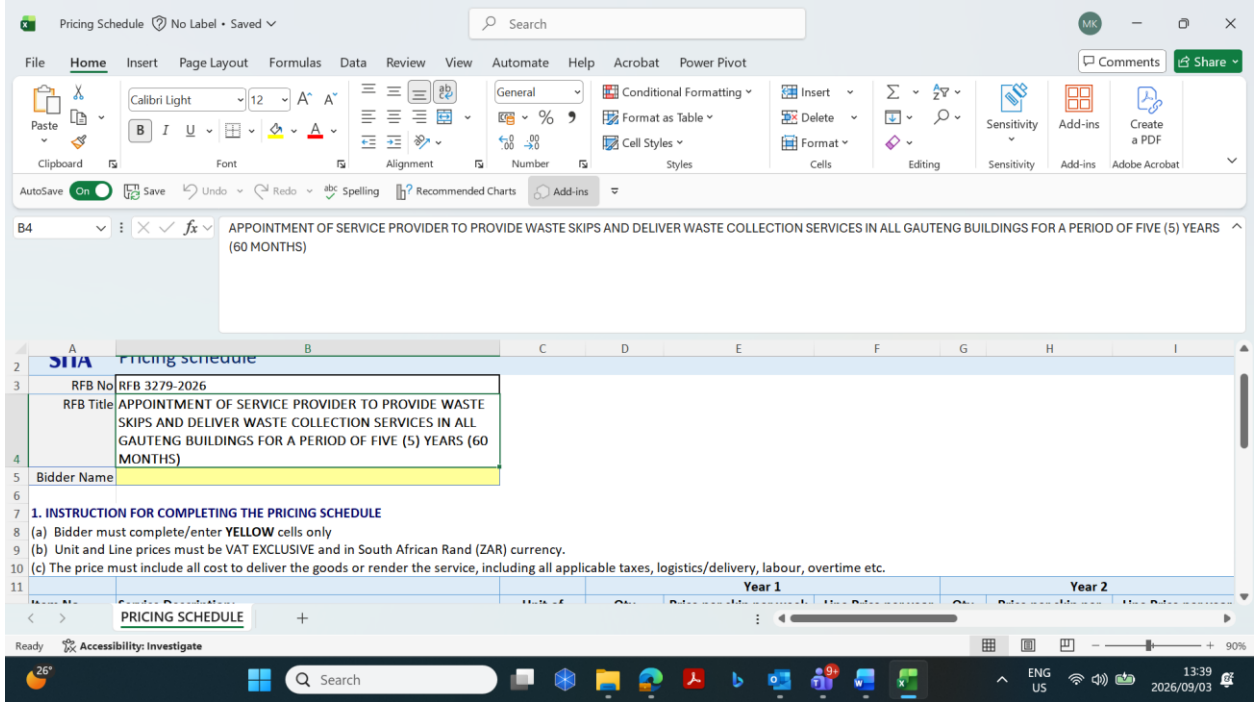


RFB 3279-2026: APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER TO PROVIDE WASTE SKIPS AND DELIVER WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES IN ALL GAUTENG BUILDINGS FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS (60 MONTHS).

No	QUESTIONS	ANSWERS
1	Just check the spreadsheet for me it's giving me wrong data on year 2 column	Kindly note formula bar on the pricing schedule Note the formula is no of bins x price per skips x 52 weeks in the year – only 1.5 is not multiplied by 52 weeks as it is ad hoc supply, delivery and collection of a max of 6 skips per year (as and when required) – bidder will only quote price per skip 
2	If suppliers are required to provide bins, we believe the pricing schedule should also include the following items: - Bin placement/delivery - Bin rental	The pricing schedule and the bid specification indicate that the RFB is for APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER TO PROVIDE WASTE SKIPS AND DELIVER WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES IN ALL GAUTENG BUILDINGS FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS (60 MONTHS).

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	- Waste collection - Waste disposal per ton	Hence the bidder must include provision of waste skips (whether they are hiring the skips/ skips are owned by the bidder) and all overheads related to provide a waste collection service as per bid spec in their price per skip price – waste collection service refers to skip placement/delivery, travel, labour, collection etc. Regardless of whether the skip is full or not (weight on collection) the service should be delivered for 52 weeks each year. 
3	As mentioned earlier, we would like to request clarification/information regarding the six skips currently being serviced on a weekly basis, to assist us in establishing an accurate baseline for our tender pricing.	The response we received from our current service provider on estimated kg per skip is anything between 120kg and 620 kg per skip. Precious contract was only 5 x 6m3 skip bins per week, but the new requirement is 6 x 6m3 skip bins per week. (and the AD Hoc skip requirements as specified in the pricing schedule)

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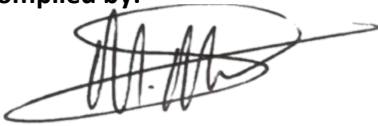
	Would it be possible to provide us with the total actual weight/tonnage collected from these six skips over a recent three-month period? As the six skips are serviced weekly, we do not require the individual weight for each skip or each collection. The total actual tonnage collected over the three-month period would be sufficient, together with confirmation of the total number of skips/collections serviced during the same period. For example, if all six skips were serviced weekly for approximately 13 weeks, this would equate to approximately 78 skip collections. We could then divide the total actual tonnage by the actual number of skips serviced to establish a realistic average weight per skip. This information would allow us to calculate a reasonable average weight per skip based on historical actual weights and use this as a baseline for determining the estimated weekly, monthly and annual tonnages required for the tender pricing. Kindly confirm whether this historical information can be provided.

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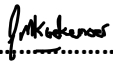
