#### 1. PURPOSE

The South African Diamond and Precious Metals Regulator ('the SADPMR) wishes to appoint a panel of service providers to provide/conduct training in the form of short courses and workshops for employees of the Regulator.

#### **Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE)**
