REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER FOR THE SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF BARB WIRE FENCE AND CONCRETE DEMARCATION MARKERS AT VARIOUS SITES WITHIN DUBE TRADEPORT PRECINCTS LOCATED IN LA MERCY AND ILLOVO

Dube TradePort Corporation (DTPC) was created as a provincial public entity to develop Dube TradePort. Refer to www.dubetradeport.co.za for more information on DTPC.

Dube TradePort Corporation (DTPC) hereby invites proposals for the supply and installation of barbwire fence and concrete demarcation markers for Dube TradePort Precinct and Illovo Precinct.

The works include, but not limited to the following:-

- Land Surveying, for setting-out and As-built drawing,
- Supply and Installation of poles and fences,
- Supply and install mass concrete to secure the fence poles,
- Supply and install concrete markers,
- Supply and Install 6 Strand Barb Wire.

It is estimated that tenderers must have a CIDB contractor grading (active) designation of 3SQ by the closing date of the bid.

PRE QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

The prequalification criterion is as follows:

- a) EME/QSE with B-BBEE Level 1

LOCAL CONTENT AND PRODUCTION

- b) In line with the National Treasury Instruction notes, this bid has a Local Production and Content for designated sectors as follows:
 - i. Steel must be 100%;
 - ii. Cement must be 100%.

It is a bidding condition that all bidders must meet the pre-qualification as well as the local production and content requirements. Any bidder that does not meet any one of these requirements is not eligible to tender and their bid proposal will not be acceptable.

Note to the Bidders: Bidders may price for one or both Illovo and Dube Site/ Precincts however DTPC will appoint/ award (1) one company per Site/ Precinct. Bidders will not be disqualified for bidding for one Site/ Precinct.

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EVALUATION OF THIS BID

All proposals will be evaluated in various stages – compliance and functionality will be assessed and thereafter all responsive proposals will be evaluated in accordance with the PPPFA regulations, 2017 using the 80/20 preference points system.
