1 Introduction

The Electoral Commission (EC) wishes to acquire appropriate laptops that will enable efficient support of business processes. The Electoral Commission wishes to update its IT hardware environment to the latest technology as well as ensuring adequate support. ICT Department intends to continue running a highly efficient and stable ICT environment making full use of industry standards, best practices and disciplines based upon stable and reliable technologies.

Suppliers must place a bid on the Votaquotes (e-Procurement) system and then provide all the required documentation before the closing date as specified in this document and on the Votaquotes web site. Bidders must register and be approved to bid on this auction.

2 Background

The Electoral Commission has invested extensively in its Information and Communication Technology (ICT) technologies, which provide a platform to effectively support and enable its business processes and to meet its goal of providing a free and fair election process in an open and transparent environment. The Electoral Commission's ICT Department intends to continue running a highly efficient and stable ICT environment making full use of industry standards, best practices and disciplines based upon stable and reliable technologies.

The Electoral Commission requires a service provider to supply and deliver supply and delivery of sixty (60) Executive laptops with docking stations and accessories as outlined in the item specification below. The required items must be supplied to the Electoral Commission's Head Office.

3 Technical Specifications

The technical specification for the required products is as per the bid specifications provided below. It must be noted that the technical specifications below are the minimum requirements. The only exception that may be accepted will be in case where the service provider's specification exceeds the minimum requirements. Any offers below the minimum specification requirement will be disqualified.

3.1 Executive Laptops Specification with Docking

The technical specification for the required equipment is detailed below and it must be noted that these are the minimum requirements, and the bidder may recommend equipment with same or better specifications. The only deviation that may be accepted will be in case where the bidder's specification is better, anything below the minimum specification will be disqualified.

4 Planning Assumptions

The Electoral Commission has made the following assumptions:

- 4.1 The Electoral Commission will provide technical resources for all Electoral Commission's designated work including setup and configuration of own systems and databases.
- 4.2 Wherever the need arises the successful bidder shall do initial equipment configuration of operating systems and environmental specific requirements.
- 4.3 The delivery of the hardware, software licenses and implementation services required must be completed within the days as stipulated in the delivery and implementation schedule below
- 4.4 The bidder's change control management process must be flexible enough to facilitate speedy deployment and resolution of problems without compromising

management controls and security.

5 General Bid Conditions

The following standard auction conditions must be adhered to and complied with, failing of which the bid will be disqualified.

- 5.1 Bidders must place bids online on the Electoral Commission's eProcurement website by not later than the stipulated closing date and time on the auction.
- 5.2 Bidder must complete and submit Technical Bid Response Sheet to show compliance with the technical bid requirements
- 5.3 The bidder must be authorized to sell the product supplied. An OEM letter of proof of the reseller agreement/authorization must accompany the written documentation for this bid. Should the reseller authorization be from a distributor, then a proof of authorization, authorizing the distributor to resell and/or to authorize others by the OEM, must be submitted
- 5.4 The bidder must provide at least two (2) contactable list of clients of past services of a similar nature. Client details must include the following: customer name, contact person, contact details (telephone, email, and physical address), service description and value of services offered, per contract. Appendix C provides a guideline and client details required, however bidders are free to format their response as they prefer. Some guideline definitions include:
- 5.5 Services rendered in the past similar project to include budget, personnel resources utilized for the duration of the contract.
- 5.6 Similar services are those services, which includes supply of similar services as per the technical requirements and of comparative value.
- 5.7 Bidders must include brochures and/or Data Sheets for the screens on a movable trolley, cameras, tripods and microphone speaker systems being proposed.
- 5.8 The Electoral Commission depreciates its IT equipment over a period of 5

years. It is therefore important that the bidder does not knowingly propose IT equipment that has a lifespan that is less than 5 years. Bidders are required to provide the lifespan of the proposed products in the form of a letter.

5.9 The bidders proposed solution should indicate warranty plan proposed, if there was no provision for warranty a minimum one-year warranty should be provisioned.

5.10 Warranty Statement: An OEM warranty statement stating all warranty terms and conditions must be submitted.

5.11 Bidders are to note that even if the solution they are offering is a touchscreen keyboard, a physical keyboard must still be provided.

6 Pricing Requirements

6.1 Bidders must complete and submit a detailed price breakdown of the proposed solution in the pricing schedule as per **Appendix B**.

6.2 Bidders are advised to take into account that the following costs are factored into the price. The Electoral Commission will not entertain additional charges on these items.

- (a) Hardware costs
- (b) Delivery costs to the Electoral Commission's offices.
- (c) VAT inclusive

6.3 Bid prices must be firm for a period of one hundred and eighty (180) days.

6.4 Total Bid price must be submitted online on the eProcurement (Votaquotes) portal.

7 Award of Contract

7.1 An official purchase order will be issued to a bidder whose bid complies with the bid specifications.

7.2 It should be noted that the Electoral Commission seeks to gain the best product technically and financially.

8 Delivery and Implementation Timeframe

- 8.1 The successful bidder must be able to complete delivery within 30 days of receiving the official purchase order.

Failure to submit all of the required documentation before the closing date and time shall invalidate the bid. It remains the responsibility of the bidder to confirm receipt of the required documentation with the Electoral Commission Procurement and Asset Management Department.

10 Summary of Submission Requirements

- 10.1 Submit bid and bid price online on the Votaquotes portal.
- 10.2 Detailed technical specifications in accordance with the technical requirements to demonstrate compliance, include technical documentation and brochures and/or datasheets as part of the bid;
- 10.3 A letter of proof of the reseller agreement either from the OEM or an authorized distributor; (i.e. if the reseller is authorized by a distributor). If the reseller agreement is from a distributor, then proof from the OEM authorizing the distributor needs to be included in the bid proposal.
- 10.4 The bidder shall provide at least two (2) list of clients of similar work including customer name, customer contact name, and contact details (email address and telephone contact). Refer to Appendix C for guideline.
- 10.5 Bidders must submit a letter providing confirmation that the lifespan of the proposed products is not less than 5 years.
- 10.6 Bidders must complete and submit technical bid response Sheet.
- 10.7 Bidders must complete and submit pricing schedule together with the bid proposal.

11 Closing Date

The closing date and time of this bid is specified on the eProcurement (Votaquotes) website in accordance the bidding requirements. The closing date and time is determined by the clock on the servers and is not negotiable. Bidders must also take note that supporting documentation must be delivered **before the closing date and time.**

Bid Evaluation Process

15.1 Stage 1: Assessment of Bidder's Disclosure

All bids received will be evaluated and assessed in respect of the mandatory information provided in the Bidder's Disclosure (SBD4) as well as the register for restricted suppliers and tender defaulters.

Any potential issues that may arise or transgressions that may identified will be pursued in accordance with statutory obligations and requirements.

In this regard, the following must be noted:

The Electoral Commission must, as part of its supply chain management (SCM) processes, identify and manage all potential conflicts of interest and other disclosures made by a person participating in procurement process to enable the accounting officer or delegated authority to make informed decisions about the person participating in the SCM process.

As such, the Bidders Disclosure form, issued as Standard Bidding Document (SBD) 4, attached as Bidder's Disclosure (SBD4), was extended to all entities which were invited to participate in the SCM process.

As part of the evaluation of the procurement process, the information provided by a person on the SBD4 form must be evaluated.

In so doing, it must be noted that if the bid evaluation establishes that:

- (b) a person within the bidding entity is an employee of the State, the Electoral Commission's Accounting Officer/accounting authority must request the relevant accounting officer/accounting authority whether the person-
 - (i) Is prohibited from conducting business with the State in terms of Section 8 of the Public Administration Management Act, 2014; or
 - (ii) has permission to perform other remunerative work outside of their employment, where the PAMA does not apply to such employee;
- (c) the conduct of a person constitutes a transgression of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act, 2004;
- (d) the conduct of a person constitutes a transgression of the Competition Act, 1998, the conduct must be reported to the Competition Commission; and
- (e) the conduct of a person must be dealt with in terms of the prescripts applicable to the Electoral Commission.

If it is established that a person has committed a transgression in terms of the above, or any other transgression of SCM prescripts, the bid may be rejected and the person may be restricted.

The Electoral Commission’s Accounting Officer/accounting authority must inform National Treasury of any action taken against a person within 30 days of implementing the action.

During the bid evaluation process, the Electoral Commission must in addition to other due diligence measures, establish if a person is not listed in-

- (a) the Register of Tender Defaulters; and
- (b) the list of restricted suppliers.

A bid related to a restricted bidder or tender defaulter shall be rejected.
