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#### SCOPE OF WORK FOR THE PANEL OF COAL SUPPLIERS

Eskom seeks to appoint a panel of coal suppliers for the supply and delivery of an estimated 8.9 million tons (Mt) of coal to Eskom coal-fired power stations on an "as and when required" basis for a period of 3 (three) years.

The process of the panel is to be carried out in 2 (two) stages:

- 1. The first stage will be an open market enquiry process where tenderers will be prequalified based on functionality and appointed to a panel of coal suppliers, and
- The second stage will be requests for quotations issued to the panel members on an 'as and when required' basis, and where feasible the reverse e-auction mechanism will be utilised.

## **Coal Quality Specifications**

The supplier shall ensure that each quality parameter of the coal delivered to Eskom shall comply with the Quality Specifications set out in column 3 of Table 1 hereunder.

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#### **Coarse Coal**

Further to the above, the scope of work includes smaller tonnage of coarse coal (>6mm) to assist with coal flowability through transfer chutes, staithes, and bunkers at power stations during periods of continued rainfall. The stations of concern are Arnot, Camden, Grootvlei, Kendal and Majuba. In acquiring the coarse coal, the coal qualities as per Table 1 will be utilized, except for the particle size distribution which will comply with Table 2 and 3 below.

- Parameters are measured to 1 (one) decimal place, except AI, HGI and AFT which shall be measured to the nearest integer and Sulphur Content which shall be measured to 2 (two) decimal places.
- \* The top size for the particle size distribution could be less than 5% plus 45mm, less than 5% plus 50mm or 0% plus 50mm depending on Eskom's requirement.
- The supplier shall ensure that no supplementary ultrafines are blended into the product and is substantially free from impurities and extraneous materials related to the proper mining and processing of coal.

This functionality evaluation and associated criteria will be used to evaluate suppliers' technical capability in terms of the services tendered for. Tenderers that are qualified from this process will be placed on the panel.

- The information in the CPR / Technical Report returnable will be scored as per Annexure P for completeness. If the respondent scores less than the threshold of 75% the respondent will score 2.5%
- For the reserve / resource tons to score 18%, the Gross Ton In-situ (GTIS) or the Total Tons In-situ (TTIS) or Mineable Tons In-situ (MTIS) must be provided
- If coal quality ranges are given in the coal quality specification offered then worse value will be
  used for scoring (i.e. lower range values for calorific values, volatiles, ash fusion temperature and
  hard-grove grindability index will be used and for sulphur, ash, total moisture, abrasiveness index
  and particle size distribution the higher range values will be used). The top size for the particle

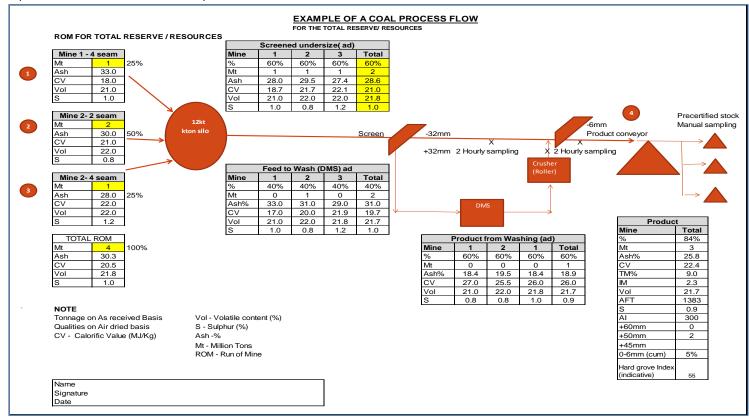
