BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF TCTA

Trans-Caledon Tunnel Authority (TCTA) is a state-owned entity charged with financing and implementing bulk raw water infrastructure projects. It is an agency of the National Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS), which is responsible for the country's water resources in respect of usage, equitable allocation and distribution. TCTA assists the government in its pursuit of water security for South Africa and in realising its constitutional obligation of ensuring universal access to this essential resource for all citizens.

South Africa is a water-scarce country, requiring a dedicated focus on ensuring adequate water storage and transfer capacity. To this end, TCTA designs bankable projects, raises funding in capital markets, manages debt and implements infrastructure rollouts.

BACKGROUND

TCTA is re-implementing the provision of office kitchen consumables with the occupation of the new office. The services were put on hold with the implementation of the COVID-19 restrictions and regulations with the intention of it being re-implemented after the lifting of these restrictions.

SCOPE OF WORK

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF GOODS/SERVICES

- 1.1 Appointment of a service provider for the provision of office kitchen consumables for a period of 24 months.
- 1.2 The service provider will be responsible for the supply and delivery of office kitchen consumables as and when required and agreed with TCTA.
- 1.3 TCTA will place orders for the required goods as and when required. The order frequency is usually once per week but this may vary in line with the business need.

- 1.4 No fewer than one order will be placed per month and it is unlikely that more than 5 orders will be placed during any given calendar month.
- 1.5 The service providers shall source and deliver the ordered items in line with the order placement and delivery schedule presented in Table 1 below.

1.3. B-BBEE

1.3.1. A bidder who fails to submit proof of B-BBEE status level of contributor or a non-compliant bidder will not be disqualified at this stage but:

1.3.1.1. May only score points out of 80 or 90 depending on which preference point system is applicable; and

1.3.1.2. Scores 0 out of 20 or 0 out of 10 depending on which preference point system is applicable.

1.3.2. A joint venture or consortium must submit a consolidated B-BBEE certificate in order to earn B-

BBEE points.

- 1.3.3. All B-BBEE certificates must be obtained from verification agencies accredited by SANAS unless the bidder is an EME or QSE in which case they must submit a validly commissioned affidavit QSEs that do not meet level 1 or 51% black ownership thresholds are obliged to show compliance with all five of the categories on the BEE scorecard therefore, a B-BBEE certificates must be obtained from verification agencies accredited by SANAS.
- 1.3.4. An EME or QSE with 100% black ownership qualifies at a Level One.
- 1.3.5. An EME or QSE with more than 51% black ownership qualifies at a Level Two.
- 1.3.6. If black ownership of an EME is below 51%, it qualifies at a Level Four.
- 1.3.7. If black ownership of a QSE is below 51%, it is required to be measured in terms of the QSE scorecard to confirm its B-BBEE Status Level.

1.4. Price

- 1.4.1. If the price offered by the highest scoring bidder is not market related, TCTA reserves the right not to award to that bidder in terms of its Procurement policies.
- 1.4.2. Price must be reflected Excluding and Including VAT.
- 1.4.3. All prices must include disbursements.
- 1.4.4. Prices must be firm and unconditional. Bids with conditional prices will not be acceptable and will be treated as such..

1.5 Failure on the part of a bidder to submit proof of B-BBEE Status level of contributor together with the bid, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for B-BBEE status level of contribution are not claimed.

1.6 The purchaser reserves the right to require of a bidder, either before a bid is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the purchaser.

2. DEFINITIONS

- (a) **“B-BBEE”** means broad-based black economic empowerment as defined in section 1 of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (b) **“B-BBEE status level of contributor”** means the B-BBEE status of an entity in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (c) **“bid”** means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an

organ of state for the provision of goods or services, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;

- (d) **“Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act”** means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (e) **“EME”** means an Exempted Micro Enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (f) **“functionality”** means the ability of a bidder to provide goods or services in accordance with specifications as set out in the bid documents.
- (g) **“prices”** includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (h) **“proof of B-BBEE status level of contributor”** means:

1)	level certificate issued by an authorized body or person;	B-BBEE Status
2)	as prescribed by the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice;	A sworn affidavit
3)	requirement prescribed in terms of the B-BBEE Act;	Any other
- (i) **“QSE”** means a qualifying small business enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (j) **“rand value”** means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;

3. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

3.1 THE 80/20 OR 90/10 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:
