1. BACKGROUND

Mhlontlo local municipality is one of the fastest growing municipalities in the OR Tambo District Municipality in Eastern Cape province. Along with the vast developments taking place in the area, a number of economic activities have been identified and are in control. These activities include Mining, Construction, Tourism and Agriculture The municipality is also investing on the upgrade and development of electrical supply in order to align with the growing need catalyzed by the current developments.

Thus, Mhlontlo Loacal Municipality is looking for sixteen suitably qualified and experienced service providers for the CONSTRUCTION OF CIVIL WORKS for a period of 36 months

2. OBJECTIVES
