

Technical evaluation Criteria – Pest Control

Stage1: Mandatory Technical Evaluation Criteria (gatekeepers) are ‘must meet’ criteria. These criteria are not weighted, or points scored but, are assessed on a Yes/No basis to ascertain whether or not the criteria are met. An assessment of ‘No’ against any mandatory criterion will disqualify the tenderer and the tenderer will not be evaluated against Qualitative Criteria.

Stage 2: Qualitative Technical Evaluation Criteria is weighted evaluation criteria used to identify the highest technically ranked tenderer. The Qualitative Evaluation Criteria are weighted to reflect the relevant importance of each criterion. The minimum weighted final score (threshold) required for a tender to be considered from a technical perspective is 80%.

The following criteria will be applicable for this transaction under functionality criteria:

The threshold on the technical evaluation criteria is **80%**. Suppliers would be deemed technically unacceptable

Tenderers who do not meet the threshold for functionality scoring will be disqualified and not be evaluated further.
