T1.1: Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

The iSimangaliso Wetland Park Authority invites tenders to bid for the Re-gravelling and blading of various Park Access Roads.

The following tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, or are capable of being so registered prior to the evaluation of submissions, are eligible to submit tenders:

- Contractors who have a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered for **6CE or Higher** class of construction work; and
- Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that:
 - every member of the joint venture is registered with the CIDB;
 - the lead partner has a contractor grading designation in the **6CE or Higher** class of construction work; and
 - the combined contractor grading designation calculated in accordance with the Construction Industry Development Regulations is equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered for an **6CE or Higher** class of construction work.

The following pre-qualification criteria applies to this tender:

- Contractors must have a CIDB contractor grade of at least grade **6CE or Higher**
- A compulsory briefing session must be attended**, only bidders who attend briefing session qualifies for evaluation.
- All returnable forms, SBDs and supporting annexures must be fully completed, signed, and witnessed using a black ink (not typed).

The tender will be evaluated on functionality/quality, and the following quality criteria are included:

E.	Bidder's Capacity: Heavy Plant and Equipment for Road Construction (Proof of Plant Ownership or Hire Agreement)	10

Minimum total point required = **75 points**

The evaluation and adjudication of tenders will be done in line with the Employer's approved Supply Chain Policy, Responsiveness, Functionality and Price. Only tenderers meet minimum qualifying score of 75% on functionality as detailed in the tender document shall qualify for further evaluation. Tender evaluation points for preferences will be allocated as indicated on PPPFA Regulations 2022 Specific Goals for 80/20 evaluation criteria.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the iSimangaliso Dredger Harbour Offices, St Lucia, 3936, on **01 June 2026 at 10h00**. The Tenderer shall inspect and examine the Site and its surroundings and shall satisfy himself before submitting his tender as to the form and nature of the Sites, the quantities and nature of the work and materials necessary for the completion of the outstanding Works and the means of access of the Site. The tenderer must be represented at the site inspection by a person who is suitably qualified and experienced to comprehend the implications of the work involved. Attendance of the site inspection is compulsory, and a tender will be disqualified if the site inspection is not attended by a representative of the tenderer.
