6. SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work will include the purchase, collection and removal of 103 MECER DESKTOPS (TOWER ONLY) FROM MKONDENI IN KWAZULUNATAL on an "as and when" required basis contract within Eskom KWAZULUNATAL Operating Unit for a contract period of three (3) years from date of signature.

The purchaser will be responsible for the safe collection, handling, removal, loading and transportation of the material and to clean the site and must provide their own Bins where necessary, qualified labour and suitable certified plant, machinery, equipment and transport for this purpose.

The **ASSETS** on sale will be identified by Eskom.

7. PRICE SCHEDULE

- a. Eskom will not be responsible for any damages or losses suffered during the removal of the equipment incurred while working on this project arising from theft, damage or personal injury.
- b. You will be required to adhere to the condition as laid out by the Eskom site agent with regards to site access etc.
