**1. Evaluation Criteria**

- Herbicide Use and Application Certificate with authorising Body (e.g. Department of Agriculture) (it can be company or key personal registration)
- Fully completed and signed form of offer.
- Only tenderers who are a CIDB contractor grading of 1SH or higher

**2. Functionality Evaluation**

- Company Experience

**3. Price and B-BBEE**

- 80/20 Split

The Tenderers need to score a minimum of **70** points out of **100** in terms of the functionality points for further evaluation.
