## **Chiefs show** 'misfiring' Caleb the door

Team believed to be searching for another striker

Kaizer Chiefs have confirmed the exit of striker Bonfils-Caleb Bimenyimana after they mutually agreed to terminate

The Burundian international joined Amakhosi last season and top scored for them with eight goals in 21 matches.

But he was no longer part of their plans this season as he didn't even make a single appearance for the club in

their opening three matches. The decision to release him was also to free up their foreign quota spot as they are believed to be searching for another striker.

"Kaizer Chiefs have come to an agreement with striker Bonfils-Caleb Bimenyimana to part ways after one season," read the statement.

"He featured 21 times for Chiefs (17 starts + 4 subs) and found the back of the net 8

"He will be free to join a team of his choice and we wish him well in his future."

The 25-year-old was linked with a move to Moroccan giants Wydad AC but the move failed to materialise at the last minute despite him

travelling to Morocco.

It remains to be seen which team he will join.

Meanwhile, Cape Town City announced they captured the services of Thabiso Kutumela on a season loan from Mamelodi Sundowns.

On Tuesday, Sundowns coach Rulani Mokwena told the media that Kutumela requested a loan in favour of game time elsewhere and City confirmed on Wednesday they signed him.

## Boxing SA urged to appoint women in key positions

Top official Zinakile backs mission to uplift women

Boxing SA (BSA) must empower women in boxing holistically and that includes employing at least one provincial manager.

That plea was made yesterday by Pumeza Zinakile, a ring official based in Johannes-

Her pleas comes few days af-BSA acting CEO Ntsikayezwe Sithole announced they would launch the "The Rise of Women in Boxing" series to empower and promote women in boxing, inside and outside the ring.

Zinakile, 42, who grew up-KwaZozo location in Kwelerha, north of East London, has been in boxing for 15 years.

In 2017, she was voted BSA female ring official of the year.

This year she lifted the same award during BSA's awards ceremony held in Durban but this time it was inclusive of her male counterparts.

To further vouch for her pedigree in the sport of fisticuffs, Zinakile is a niece of former two weight SA and IBO champion, Zolile "Bone Crusher" Mbityi.

On Law of the List, which rates female referees, she is rated No 6 licensed by WBA, WBO, IBF, IBO and WBF.

Zinakile said she was happy with Boxing SA's idea for promoting women in the nationwide boxing series of female boxers tournaments from this month until March next year.

Sithole said The Rise of Women in Boxing series would make a stop in each province, with Eastern Cape having two bites of the cherry in East London and Gqeberha.

The only missing piece in the puzzle is the female provincial manager.

"How nice it was going to be for females to be supervising those tournaments," Zinakile remarked.

"[But] that has to be done on

merit and not appoint a female just to be seen to be politically correct. I truly believe that Siya Vabaza has all the qualifies to do that job; experience, she is qualified academically and she's been a ring official for like 30 years; she knows everything about boxing."

She added that the planned series for women's boxing "will give action to female promoters, ring officials, managers and ring announcers".

"I want to pay tribute to [promoterl Mbali Zantsi who flew female ring officials all over the country for her Women Only tournament in Kagiso in 2015.

"Zandile Malinga did the same in 2016 in Durban. A day after that tournament, all females had a convention and deliberated on challenges that faces them in boxing.

"One resolution taken there was that male referees must not be appointed in women bouts because they are unable to perform some of the important duties, like re-inserting protectors to their breasts during fights."

As a gesture of giving back, last year Zinakile sponsored four local gyms in Kwelerha with training equipment including boxing gloves and punching bags. She's also involved in a mis-

sion to donate sanitary towels and clothes to girls.
