A. Fixed Service

- The required human resources will do the following:
- Clean major fuel oil spillages from the plant (east and west).
- Clean all major chemical spillages at WTP.
- Clean all major spillages from main turbine oil tanks unit 1 to 6 (types of oil)
- Clean all major spillages from Sulphur common tanks.
- Clean all major spillages from Diesel and petrol in fuel stations.
- Clean all major spillages from Main lubrication storage tanks.

Clean all major spillages from the boilers up to zero-meter level including the structures.

- Recover oil from the station oil ponds and station dams.
- Contain the recovered oil in form of drums or any other appropriate containers.
- Clean any other chemical spills at Lethabo Power Station
- Transport the contained chemical spills to the registered hazardous land fill site.
- Transport the oil absorbent or oil contaminated ash/soil to the landfill site (housekeeping)
- A waste disposal certificate and manifest must be provided as proof of disposal.
- Provide the correct colour coded skips / container to contain any chemical / oil and contaminated materials.

• Provide the specific oil and chemical absorbent.

B. On-Demand Services or Call outs and standby

The On-Demand Services or Callouts shall be provided by the contractor on request by the employer on an emergency basis (24hours) at agreed rates of the called-out personnel provided the services.
