Bidders are advised not to commit fraudulent activities or forge documents. All abusers of the SCM system, including forging or faking of returnable documents, may be reported to SAPS and restricted from doing business with any Public Institutions for a period NOT exceeding 10 years which is in line with section 28 and 29 of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act 12 of 2004.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF THE BID

1. SUBMISSION OF TENDERS

The tender is to be made out on the tender form attached hereto, which must not be detached from this document, and the completed document, fully priced, extended and totalled, completed in all respects, signed and is to be sealed in an envelope which is to be enclosed and delivered in accordance with the instructions contained on the Invitation to Tender.

Proof of posting of a tender will not be accepted as proof of delivery to the appropriate place for the receipt of tender.

Tenders will be opened in public immediately after the advertised closing date.

The information to be submitted by prospective bidders will only be used for tender purposes taking into consideration the Protection of Personal Information Act (POPI Act).

2. TENDER DEPOSIT

Tender documents can be downloaded from the City's website: www.mbombela.gov.za, in the tenders and notices folder and e-Tender Portal: www.etenders.gov.za, free of charge.

3. ADJUDICATION OF TENDER

The City of Mbombela will not be bound to accept the lowest or any tender and also reserves the right to cancel the tender when deemed necessary.

The tender will be adjudicated by City of Mbombela in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, no. 5 of 2000 and as defined in the conditions of bid in the bid document, read in conjunction with the preferential procurement regulations, 2022, where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of targeted goals.

The certified proof of relevant SANS certificate must be attached. Should the bidder be a third party, supporting documents including but not limited to, letter of intent / support, certified copy of relevant SANS certificate from the manufacturer or distributor must be attached. Failure to adhere will lead to immediate elimination.

Prospective service providers may not make any alterations or additions to the Bid document, except to comply with instructions issued by the employer. The tender document must be furnished with non-erasable black ink and all corrections made by the service provider should be dated and signed by the authorised signatory. Erasures and the use of masking fluid, tippex, pencil or erasable ink are prohibited and failure to adhere to this condition will render your submission non responsive.

Certified copy of B-BBEE Certificate OR Original Sworn Affidavit for B-BBEE / certified copy of a Sworn Affidavit for B-BBEE. Failure to adhere will lead in non-claiming on preferential points.

A bid not complying with the mandatory requirements stated in the bid document will be regarded as non-responsive and as such will be rejected. If a Bid has not been properly signed by a party having the authority to do so, according to the example of "Authority for Signatory" will be rejected. This condition will not apply to companies owned by one director / member / sole proprietorship.

A bid will be rejected if any municipal rates and taxes or municipal service charges owed by the bidder or any of its directors to the municipality, or to any other municipality or municipal entity, are in arrears for more than three months. Similarly, none submission of proof of valid and up-to-date rates and taxes statement will render the submission non-responsive.

Bids will be rejected if the bidders or any of the directors are listed on the Register of Bid Defaulters in terms of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act of 2004 as a person prohibited from doing business with the public sector. Bids will be rejected if the bidder has abused the CoM's Supply Chain Management System or SCM Processes of any state institutions.

Prospective bidders must attach proof of forklift ownership, if the forklift belongs to a third party, the proof of ownership must be accompanied by a letter of agreement. A forklift may be substituted by a truck with an installed crane and same conditions of a forklift will apply. Failure to adhere to these conditions will render your bid nonresponsive.

City of Mbombela reserves the right to visit the warehouse without prior notice as part of the evaluation process to minimise risk associated with project failure.

MBD 1 will be regarded as a FORM OF OFFER and if the form is not completed in full and signed by the authorised signatory, the submission will be regarded as non-responsive.

4. COMPLETION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS

Tenders will only be considered on receipt of this tender document correctly completed with all insertions in black ink and signed.

The following **compulsory** documentation **must** be attached in order for the bid to be considered:

- Valid Tax Compliance Status
- Company Registration Certificate
- Formal agreement (in case of consortia/Joint Ventures)
- Full CSD Registration report NOT OLDER THAN 30 DAYS (Summary Report will NOT be acceptable).
- Certified ID copies of company directors.
- Relevant Annual Financial Statements (AFS) for the latest 3 consecutive years.
- Copies of current municipal rates and taxes statements from relevant local authority / proof of residential from tribal authority (if the business is operating or the directors are residing in rural areas) / lease agreement with the lessor's up-to-date municipal rates and taxes statements for both the business and all active directors including JVs and consortium partners. Prospective bidders should ensure that the physical address details of the company and directors reflected on the CSD is similar to the one reflected on the company registration certificate. The municipality reserves the right to verify both the municipal rates and taxes of the company details reflected on the CSD and company registration certificates. The municipality further reserves the right to use ID numbers of the directors to verify if any municipal rates and taxes are not owned by each director. It is prudent and remains the responsibilities of the prospective bidders to ensure that each director, lessor and company rates are cleared with regards to the municipal rates and taxes.

- Certified copy of a Test Certificate containing the particulars with detailed information about the cable on the drum.
- Certified copy of SABS assessment certificate not older than 12 months from the closing date.

NB: Certified copies of documentation must not be older than three months to be regarded as valid. Copies of “certified copies” will not be acceptable as true copies of original documents. Failure to adhere will lead to immediate disqualification.

5. BRIEFING SESSION

No compulsory tender briefing session shall be conducted for this tender. Technical enquiries may be directed to the project manager (see contact details on page 5).

6. TAXES AND DUTIES PAYABLE

Bidders shall allow in their tenders for the payment and recovery of all taxes and other duties. No claims for additional payment in this respect will be considered. Prices and rates quoted shall be inclusive of Value Added Tax (VAT). VAT shall be recorded as a lump sum in the tender summary and the total inclusive of VAT carried to the Form of Tender.

7. WITHDRAWAL OF TENDER

In the event of the successful tender failing to execute the service in terms of this tender, the Municipality shall be entitled to cancel the contract summarily, in which event the Bidder shall be liable for any additional expense incurred by reason of the Municipality having to call for fresh tenders or having to accept any less favourable tender.

8. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF TENDERS

The period of validity of tenders shall be **120** days as stated in the tender form and be calculated from the closing date for submission of tenders.

9. NOTICE OF BIDDERS

Should any additions or alterations to the document as issued to Bidders be deemed necessary prior to the date for submission of tenders, they will be issued to Bidders in the form of Notices and will form part of the tender document.

The Notices to Bidders shall be completed where applicable by Bidders, signed, dated and returned with the tender documents.

10. DELIVERY, RISK & PENALTIES

Bidders shall clearly state the delivery period within which the delivery will be made after receipt of the official order, as this may be material in the adjudication of the tender as indicating unreasonable delivery period will lead to immediate disqualification.

The cables are mainly used by the City for the maintenance of current infrastructure. It is against that background that only embossed cable length on the PVC outer sheath at one-meter intervals in order to ascertain how much cable is left on the drum will be accepted.

Cost of delivery and off-loading shall be amortised into the bid price per item. Delivery of goods shall be by road to the following specified locations as specified at the time of order:

City of Mbombela, Main-Stores Fredenheim road, Kanaal street Municipal stores, Central Region.

City of Mbombela, Sub-Stores Hospital Street, Barberton - Umjindi Stores, Southern Region.

City of Mbombela, Sub-Stores Industrial Road, White River Stores, Eastern Region.

11. PRICE

All prices must include, delivery, off-loading, embossment and VAT where applicable. All prices must be stated in South African currency (ZAR).

The total bid price in the bill of quantities is meant for evaluation purposes only. This contract shall be rates based due to its nature. In light of this, the total bid price will not be reflected on the appointment letter.

11.1 RATE OF EXCHANGE

The first adjustment of the price(s) declared on the OFFICIAL TENDER FORM shall be undertaken when the Contractor(s) receives the first "Official Purchase Order", on condition that:

- a) The Contractor(s), within seven-days of receiving the "Official Purchase Order", arranges "forward exchange cover" i.e. fixing the rate of exchange;
- b) The "forward exchange cover" is arranged via a reputable South African bank; and
- c) The "forward exchange cover" shall be firm for the first month from the date of the "Official Purchase Order".

Hence, the first adjustment of price(s) declared on the OFFICIAL TENDER FORM shall take into account any variation in the rates of exchange between the following dates:

- i) The date of the base rate as that published by a reputable South African bank seven days prior to bid closing; and
- ii) The date the "forward exchange cover" is arranged after the first "Official Purchase Order".

The adjustment of price(s) shall then be undertaken for subsequent orders provided that the Contractor(s) arranges "forward exchange cover" via a reputable South African bank after each order. The price difference shall be paid or deducted by the Municipality in correlation with any increase or decrease in the basic rate of exchange.

Upon the failure of the Contractor(s) to arrange "forward exchange cover", the Contractor(s) shall be liable should there be an increase in the basic rate of exchange occurring after the last-mentioned date.

11.2 SEIFSA INDICES

The first adjustment of the price(s) declared on the OFFICIAL TENDER FORM shall be undertaken when the Contractor(s) receives the first "Official Purchase Order" and shall take into account any variation in indices between the:

- i) indices published by SEIFSA two-months prior to bid closing; and
- ii) indices published by SEIFSA two-months prior to the date of the first "Official Purchase Order".

The adjustment of price(s) for subsequent orders shall then be undertaken on the date of every order in accordance with the respective indices, two-months prior, as those published by SEIFSA.

11.3 CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI)

The first adjustment of the price(s) declared on the OFFICIAL TENDER FORM shall be undertaken when the Contractor(s) receives the first "Official Purchase Order" and shall take into account any variation in the CPI between the:

- i) CPI published by Statistics South Africa two-months prior to bid closing; and
- ii) CPI published by Statistics South Africa two-months prior to the date of the first "Official Purchase Order".

The adjustment of price(s) for subsequent orders shall then be undertaken on the date of every order in accordance with the CPI two month prior, as those published by Statistic South Africa.

11.4 Bidders are requested to use the latest metal and PVC Cable Compound prices as a basis for this bid. SA currency per metric ton excluded VAT.
