The Blue Crane Route Municipality invites tenders for the Installation of Street and High Mast Lighting in All Six Wards (Construction – Cookhouse).

The contract will be constructed over 20 weeks, and it is estimated that Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of **3EP** or higher.

The contractor must be registered at the Electrical Conformance Board of South Africa and the Department of Employment and Labour as an Electrical Contractor.

INVITATION AND SCOPE OF WORK

Suitably experienced and qualified Contractors are invited to respond to this Tender invitation T04/2026 for the Cookhouse Infill Lighting in Cookhouse which is to be completed over 20 weeks (..... Supply and installation of 97 x 9,5m new streetlight poles and 97 x luminaries, as well as the associated new ± 2200m LV streetlight underground cabling, and repair and re-commissioning of faulty streetlight circuits.)

COMPULSORY TENDER CLARIFICATION MEETING
