TENDER NO. 24/2025: INVITATION TO SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR THE PROVISION OF WATER TANKER SERVICES FOR uMGUNGUNDLOVU DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY

The uMgungundlovu District Municipality seeks professional service providers for the provision of Water Tanker Services. This invitation calls for the provision of a potable water delivery service to rural areas situated within the uMgungundlovu District Municipality. The duration of the contract will be for 3 years. An estimated minimum of **46 Water Tanker Trucks**, each with a minimum capacity of 16,000 Litres for transportation and delivery, are required to service the needs of the District Municipality.

Non-attendance at the Compulsory Briefing Session will render any submission invalid.

Tender submissions must be properly bound and must be placed in the tender box situated on the ground floor of the uMgungundlovu District Municipality, 242 Langalibalele Street, Pietermaritzburg, before **12H00 on 4 DECEMBER 2025**, in a sealed envelope which is clearly marked with the Tender Number and Tender Description. Late quotations or Tenders received by way of Facsimile or E-Mail will under no circumstances be considered.

All eligibility criteria must be furnished accordingly, where, mandatory or applicable. Tenderers will thereafter be evaluated in terms of functionality. Tenderers that qualified in terms of the functionality criteria will then be evaluated in terms of the 90/10 preference point system as prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022.

- At least 1 completed project/contract appointment and reference letter, with a minimum of R 10 000 000 per project/contract value from an Organ of the State.
- uMgungundlovu District Municipality reserves the right to appoint *more than 1 service provider* to fulfil the scope of works accordingly.
- Service Providers shall ensure that the Water Tankers are adequately insured. The tenderer must also have Public Liability insurance to the value of at least R10 Million. Proof of insurance is to be submitted.
- Tenderers are to submit the following information certificates/proof Manufactures certificate together with their Tenders. The certificates should confirm the following (All the below Certificates must be in the name of the Tenderer):

- I. The material used to build tank – Stainless Steel 3CR12.
- II. Minimum Tank Capacity of 16,000Lt
- III. The vehicle is fitted with a power take-off (PTO) pump system.
- IV. The transmission of the vehicle must be as specified by the applicable traffic legislation. The vehicle is manual or automatic, 6X4 or 6X6.
- V. Proof of Ownership (In the name of the tender) per Tanker of the total proposed/declared vehicles.
- VI. Proof of COR, Licence disc, road worth certificate and tracker certificate per vehicle.
- VII. The vehicle is a rigid truck with a minimum output of 260KW/350hp at 1900rpm (or Higher).

Tenderers will be evaluated in terms of functionality as part of the minimum requirements before being evaluated on price and preference based on the following criteria:

A bidder/s that scores less than **70 points out of 100** in respect of functionality will be regarded as submitting a non-responsive bid and will be disqualified.

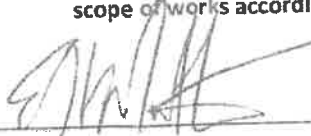
The 90/10 preference point system in terms of the municipality's SCM Policy will be applicable as follows:

****Joint Venture:** Each Company will be evaluated individually, and the cumulative points will be divided to establish average to obtain Final Specific Goal Points.

All service providers intending to submit a tender are required to be registered on the Central Supplier Database. Tenderers shall take note of the following Tender Conditions:

- uMgungundlovu District Municipality's procurement policy will apply,
- uMgungundlovu District Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or any other tender.
- Tenders submitted are to be valid for a period of **90 days** from the closing date for submissions of tenders.
- uMgungundlovu District Municipality reserves the right to appoint **more than 1 service provider** to fulfil the scope of works accordingly.
