

**ERRATUM/CORRECTION OF ERROR****CORRECTION OF SPECIFIC GOALS**

Tender Description: request for quotation to procure laptops and accessories.

The National Heritage Council (NHC) hereby issues this **Erratum** to correct an error identified in the tender documentation relating to the allocation of points for **Specific Goals under the 80/20 preference point system**.

The original tender document incorrectly allocated **6 points** to the promotion of women-owned enterprises. This resulted in the total points allocated to specific goals amounting to **22 points**, instead of the prescribed **20 points** under the 80/20 preference point system.

Corrected Specific Goals Allocation

The allocation of points is hereby corrected as follows:

This correction ensures that the total specific goals allocation is correctly aligned to **20 points under the 80/20 preference point system**.

All other terms, conditions, requirements and provisions of the tender remain unchanged.

Bidders are requested to take note of the above correction and use the **corrected specific goals allocation** when completing their tender submissions.
