BACKGROUND

The ARC-Roodeplaat campuses currently have 7 x size 6 (4.6 cubic metres) waste disposal skips which are replaced by 7 x empty skips at weekly intervals. The current service and conditions need to be extended for a period of 11 months as per operational requirements from June 2022 to April 2023. Four x portable serviced ablution facilities are required in fields with ARC-VIMP campus in line with applicable OHSA legislation.

SPECIFICATIONS

The following specifications should be followed closely by the waste disposal service provider.

1. The ARC-VIMP Roodeplaat campus is situated at Kameeldrift, Roodeplaat Pretoria. The campus is located 11.5 km - North from the crossing of Zambezi Road and the R573 KwaMhlanga Road.
2. Seven (7) 4.6 cubic metre skips are required which need to be collected and replaced by 7 empty skips each week for a period of 24 months. Each skip to be emptied four times a month x 7 skip. 28 skip loads per month.
3. The 7 skips need to be placed and collected at 7 x designated areas on the ARC-VIMP campus.
4. The service provider must provide contactable numbers in order to arrange for the collection and replacement of fully laden skips should this event occur from time to time within 7 days of the date the written request has been made.
5. The waste will consist of the following materials / matter:
 - a. General domestic waste.
 - b. General laboratory waste: boxes, paper, broken glass containers, packaging material, gloves masks, disposable dishes, pipettes, etc.
 - c. General farm and facility waste: Packaging materials, general ablution facilities waste, sanitary bin waste, wooden and metal off cuts, various piping off cuts, used plastic and metal containers / drums
 - d. Used PPE's such as masks and gloves.
 - e. General light construction waste.
 - f. Farm waste
6. The waste disposal operator must have a valid registration and or license under the NEMWA Act, National Environment Management Act 2008 (NEMA) Act No. 107 of 1998.
7. The Consignee and Waste Management Facility service provider will furnish all required documentation and information as may be required by the NEMWA Act. Act no. 17 of 1998.
8. The service provider should provide detailed invoices at monthly intervals for the period of appointment. The invoices should reach the designated ARC Facilities staff member at least one week prior to allow timeous processing of payment.



9. The provision of 4 (four) serviced portable ablution facilities at ARC-VIMP campus fields. The portable units should be serviced weekly by cleaning, removal and disposal of waste and replenishment of ablution chemicals.
10. The service provider (SP) shall provide a detailed costs table for each of the services rendered.
11. The SP must be registered on the CSD database and must follow all PFMA regulations and processes.
