The defined terms in the Contract will, unless otherwise indicated, have the same meaning in this Schedule of Requirements. In consideration of the mutual covenant and agreements contained in the Contract and in this Schedule of Requirements, it is agreed as follows:

1. Description of the Services

The scope of services to be performed by the service provider is the provision of independent review of Transnet National Ports Authority tariff methodology for a period of eight (8) months. The details for the services to be provided are as stipulated in clause 2 below.

2. Scope of Services

 Comprehensive assessment of the Required Revenue/ Rate of Return tariff methodology and components thereof. The full scope of work is attached hereto as Annexure A.

4. Performance Review Meetings

Contract management and performance review meetings will be held on a quarterly basis. The performance of the service provider will be managed by strictly adhering to the following key deliverables:

- Project plan from service provider with clear plan of: Achievement of milestones, timeframes and deliverables;
- Data collection methodology and approach;
- o Data analysis;
- o Establishment of a Steering Committee;
- o Minutes of every meeting conducted towards the project;
- Weekly progress reports;
- o Report on each project output;
- Project presentation(s) for stakeholder engagements;
- o Internal and external workshops; and
- Final report as detailed in Scope of Works.

5. Fees & Disbursements

- 5.1 In consideration of the performance of the Services by the Service Provider pursuant to this Work Order, Transnet will pay to it an amount not exceeding R 0 000 000.00 (excluding/including VAT) over the eight month period.
- 5.2 Any disbursement not specifically priced for will not be considered/accepted by Transnet. Travel bookings must be made in line with the Transnet Travel Policy. The overall cost quoted shall be inclusive of all travel and accommodation costs that will be required to complete the scope of services in full. Accommodation and Flights shall be arranged at Government Rates (3 star accommodation) and Economy Class Flights and Basic Car Hire (Group B).
- 5.3 Disbursements will be reimbursed at cost price upon presentation of an undisputed invoice. Any disbursement invoiced that is not in line with aforementioned guidelines will not be accepted by Transnet for payment.
