10	Who will be required to submit Test Reports?	Shortlisted bidders will be required to submit a Valid test report from any SANAS Accredited institutions. Refer to paragraph 6.3.8 of Special Condition of Contract.
11	What type of a Test Report required?	Only Test Report from SANAS accredited institution will be permitted, failure to do so will lead to a disqualification. Over and above that all components or elements should be measured or evaluated and the results must indicate as passed. A Test Report that has partial elements or components measured or evaluated will not be accepted.
12	Should the bidder complete the Local Content Declaration Templates?	Yes, the bidder will be disqualified if Declaration Certificate and the Annex C (Local Content Declaration: Summary Schedule) are not submitted as part of the bid documentation and if the bidder fails to declare that the Local Content Declaration Templates (Annex C, D and E) have been audited and certified as correct.
